PIONEER PATTERNS

In tribute to the sacrifice and achievements of the first Latter-day Saints, this quilt print was designed to depict the early days and events of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. Enjoy a look back at early Utah pioneer history in this quilt-style piece by Eric Dowdle.

1. Joseph Smith Jr.'s first vision.
2. "Early in the spring of 1820" was when the first vision occurred.
3. 23 September, 1823—Moroni, an angel, visited Joseph Smith and reveals the location of plates that contain the Book of Mormon.
4. Smith family home in Palmyra, NY.
5. 1st temple built in Kirkland, OH
6. Joseph Smith home in Kirkland, OH
7. 15 May 1823—restoration of the Aaronic Priesthood
8. 6 April, 1830—the Church is organized
9. Church to be called the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints
10. John the Baptist restores the Aaronic Priesthood.
11. Brigham Young's house in Nauvoo
12. 2nd temple built in Nauvoo, IL
13. Nauvoo Mansion House
14. 27 June 1844—while under protection of the state of Illinois, Joseph Smith and his brother Hyrum Smith were assassinated in Carthage, IL.
15. The sacrifice of families who buried loved ones along the trail west.
16. 14 January, 1847—Brigham Young organized companies to leave Winter Quarters, IA and head west for a new home.
17. The Seventies Hall in Old Nauvoo, IL
18. 3rd temple built in St. George, UT
19. Brigham Young house in St. George
20. 24 July—the first pioneer company entered the valley with Brigham's famous quote, "This is the right place. Drive on."
21. Conestoga wagons were how the original companies crossed the prairie.
22. This is the Place Monument in Salt Lake City, UT
23. One of Brigham Young's houses in outside of Salt Lake City, UT
24. 1847 is when the valley of the Great Salt Lake was settled.
25. 1997 was the 150th Anniversary of the pioneers arrival in the valley.
26. The Lion House in Salt Lake City—now a great place to eat.
27. The Salt Lake City Temple is the flagship temple for the Church and was the 6th temple completed.
28. The red band represents blood and sacrifice
29. The center area represents the rest of Heaven. "All is well."
