If you can hear the “Woo, Pig! Sooie!” you know you’re at the Arkansas Razorback stadium. But the Razorbacks didn’t have Tusk the Hog as their mascot until 1910. In 1909, the football team finished a 7–0 season, allowing only 18 points on defense and scoring 186 points on offense. Hugo Bezdek, a College Football Hall of Fame coach, proclaimed his team played “like a wild band of razorback hogs”. The name proved so popular that it was changed!
