



Personalizing Student Settings for Playing Assignments

1. Set the support level for assigned activities when the activity allows it by **Selecting Supported Mode** or **Independent Mode** beside the activity.




2. Personalize the student's User Settings by selecting Edit.



3. Within User Settings you may change default settings to interface, access, speech settings, and symbol settings by selecting the appropriate tab and making changes.



Playing, Removing, or Editing Activity Settings within the Assignment List



- Select Play to preview or play an activity. NOTE: Data is not collected when playing from the assignment list.
- 2. Select Edit Activity Settings to make changes to settings including support, feedback, and rewards.
- 3. Select Remove Activity to delete the activity from the student's assignments. This does NOT remove it from My Activities.
