<p>Book Template – Text on Bottom</p> <p><i>Books and Presentations</i> – Onscreen</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A structured format to create and present onscreen books. Create novel interactive stories and adaptations of children's books. Try this! – Print this book out to use as a tabletop activity or add to class library. 		
<p>Sequence Numbered 5 Steps Vertical</p> <p><i>Visual Schedules and Sequences</i> – Vertical – Onscreen</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> An effective format to teach procedural skills and establish classroom routines. Review a daily schedule, activity schedule or as a procedural checklist. Try this! – Post procedural checklists around the classroom for various routine tasks. 		
<p>Calendar 1 year January - December</p> <p><i>Calendars</i> – Onscreen</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teaches the abstract concepts of time through interacting with concrete visual supports. Highlight important weekly, monthly, or yearly events. Try this! – Add classroom events such as birthdays, therapy schedules and field trips. 		
<p>One to One</p> <p><i>Mathematics</i> – Counting – Onscreen</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teach one to one correspondence, an essential early pre-math and pre-literacy skill. Create a high interest onscreen activity with manipulatives. Try this! – Try a variety of symbols and images including curriculum related vocabulary, students' pictures, pop culture images, and motivating reinforcers. 		
<p>Stamping</p> <p><i>Art and Creativity</i> – Onscreen</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> An interactive, language rich instructional activity. Use for pre-literacy instruction, as an interactive visual scene, and for art. Try this! – Use photographs to make it more meaningful for the student. Simply drag and drop the image from your computer or the web onto the button.

Gadget - A collection of preprogrammed buttons to build or enhance an onscreen activity.

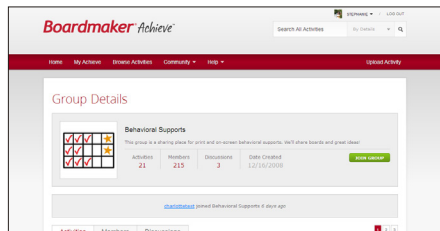
Gadget	Teaching Tips	
Timer Bars (Various times) <i>Time</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A visual support to represent a set time. Try this! - Use in conjunction with another onscreen activity or by itself to help students stay focused and teach students sense of time. 	 Timer Bar
Spinner <i>Mathematics</i> - Spinners	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A tool that randomly makes an on screen selection that mimics a game spinner. Try this! - Make common classroom selections such as line leader, snack choices, and classroom jobs and for practice turn-taking. 	 Spinner Gadget

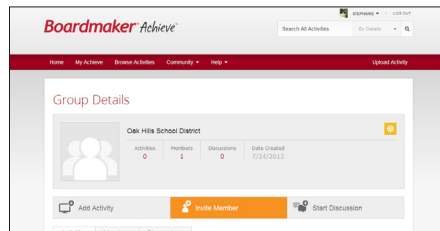

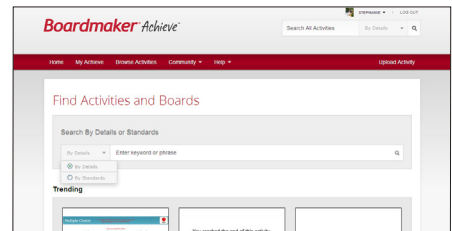
