


Getting Started with Reading Avenue

To Access Reading Avenue

Log into Boardmaker Online and select the Curriculum tab.



Under Reading Avenue, select Use It.




Select US.

Select a Unit.



NOTE- Select a unit that interests your students, or a unit covered in your state's curricula.

Select the **Avenue Selection Tool**. This tool is designed to guide you towards the best starting place for your students.




NOTE: The Avenue Selection Tool is the same in all units.

Select Play.




Select the description that most accurately describes your student or group of students. The recommended avenue will display at the bottom.



To print this activity for your records, select the two arrows in the top left corner. Then select the print icon.

You may choose to start all students on Avenue A. This can promote independent practice, success in learning, and supply additional hours in literacy instruction.

Resources- lesson plans, parent letter, and visual schedules for each day of instruction


Quiz- Identify letter sounds and rimes NOTE: These can be used at any time in the lesson cycle to collect data. The quizzes are different for each unit.

5 Books- each book has three days of guided reading, word work and writing activities. An activity set is also provided for independent practice.

Interactive Books- allows you to assign all the books in a unit to a student for independent reading

Printable Books- print books to add to classroom or home libraries


Select the Quick Lesson Guide. This is your lesson plan for the unit. It lists the target letters and rime endings for the unit and gives lesson plans for each day's activities. Print these out and you are ready to deliver instruction for the entire unit.




NOTE: Print and send the parent letter home at the beginning of each unit. Print schedules as needed for student visual supports throughout each lesson.

Implementing Instruction in Reading Avenue

Following the Quick Lesson Guide, **select a book**. That opens the books, activity sets, and activities needed for each day's instruction.





Each activity or activity set has options you can manage. These are found in the tool bar to the right of each activity set or activity.





To **print** the activity or save a PDF version to your computer, select the print icon.



To **play** the activity, select the Play button. NOTE: To play an activity set, you must first select the activity set.



To **assign** an activity or activity set to a student, Select the Assign button. Then select the student(s) that need to access the activity. NOTE: Activities assigned to students can be accessed by the student anywhere including home via computer, iPad, or Tobii communication device. Maximize the time your students engage in literacy by assigning books and activities students can review at home.



To add an activity or activity set to your **playlist** to access later from My Classroom View or an iPad, select the Playlist button.
