#### FALL HAZARD - TO PREVENT FALLS;

 DO NOT USETHIS PRODUCT WHEN INFANT BEGINSTO PUSH UP ON HANDS AND KNEES OR HAS REACHED MANUFACTURER'S MAXIMUM WEIGHT OF 8KGS, WHICHEVER COMES FIRST.

#### **SUFFOCATION HAZARD - INFANTS HAVE SUFFOCATED:**

- IN GAPS BETWEEN EXTRA PADDING AND SIDE OF BASSINET /CRADLE, AND ON SOFT BEDDING.
- NEVER ADD A PILLOW, COMFORTER OR ANOTHER MATTRESS FOR PADDING.
- USE ONLYTHE PAD PROVIDED BY MANUFACTURER.

If sheet is used with the pad, use only the one provided by the bassinet manufacturer or one specifically designed to fit the bassinet.

To reduce the risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS), paediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.

Use bassinet with only child at a time.

**ALWAYS** attach all provided fasteners (strings, straps, clamps etc...) tightly to the bassinet according to the instructions. Check frequently. Strings can cause strangulation! **DO NOT** place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over a bassinet or attach strings to toys.

**DO NOT** leave child unattended in the bassinet.

**ALWAYS** make sure the wheels or stands are in the locked "down" position.

**NEVER** place bassinet near a window where cords from curtains can strangle a child.

Adult assembly is required.

Remove any tools or excess parts including plastic packaging from the bassinet vicinity after its assembly.

Discontinue use of the bassinet before the infant can sit up by themselves.

Padding and cushioning materials, including the mattress are to be sufficiently firm to preclude conforming to the contours of the infants face.

Ensure proper ventilation is maintained in and around the bassinet by limiting bed clothes, extra pillows or toys.

Ensure the bassinet is placed at a reasonable distance from curtains, blinds, heaters and power points.

Ribbons or lace associated with the bedding may entangle the infant.

Promptly replace worn out or broken parts.

Please keep medication, string, elastic, small toys or small items such as money out of reach from any position in the bassinet.

#### RECOMMENDED MATTRESS SIZE (SUPPLIED)

This bassinet has been manufactured for use with a mattress which measures 415mm wide x 765mm long x 30mm in thickness. The width and length are specified because it is important that the gaps between the mattress and the sides and ends of the bassinet will not exceed 40mm. This is to minimise the risk of a child's limb becoming caught in the gap.





#### **ASSEMBLY / OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**



#### To assemble Bassinet Frame...




1a. Lay Top Frame face down on a flat surface.



- 2
- 2a. Insert 1 xTop Leg into the Leg Housing on the Top Frame.
- 2b. Screw in Top Leg clockwise until secure.
- 2c. Repeat for remaining 3 x Top Legs.



- 3
- 3a. Assemble Cross Brace onto the Top Legs.
- 3b. Ensure the Silver Metal Stud on the Cross Brace housing is facing upward.



- 4
- 4a. Insert 1 x Bottom Leg through the Cross Brace housing and into the Top Leg.
- 4b. Screw in Bottom Leg clockwise until secure.
- 4c. Repeat for remaining 3 x Top Legs.



- 5
- 5a. Flip Bassinet right-way up.
- 5b. Lightly push down on Bassinet Top Frame to ensure the adjustable feet are sitting flat on your floor surface.

#### To assemble Bassinet Frame continued...



1a. Secure the Bassinet to the Cross Brace using the 4 x Velcros located on the underside of the Bassinet.



The bassinet is now ready for use.

#### To attach Toy Bar...



- 1a. Align Toy Bar with Bassinet Top Rail long sides.
- 1b. Push down on Toy Bar until it 'clicks' into place and is secure.



**CAUTION:** Never use the Toy Bar to lift the Bassinet.



- 2a. Feed Toy attachment rope up and through the pre-drilled hole in the Toy Bar to the desired length.
- 2b. Tie the end of the attachment rope into a knot to secure.
- 2c Repeat for remaining two toys.

## To remove Bassinet lining...



 Unfasten all Velcro tabs from the underside of the Bassinet.

2a. Locate and unzip the zips at both ends of the Bassinet Top Rail Lining.

2b. Remove Bassinet lining from Top Rail Frame.



## To assemble Bassinet lining...



- 1a. Insert Bassinet liner inside the Bassinet frame.
- 1b. Wrap Bassinet Top Rail fabric over Top Rail frame.Zip one side of the Top Rail fabric half way
- 1c. along the Bassinet.
- 1d. Zip the remaining side Top rail fabric half way along the Bassinet.
- 1e. Check that the Bassinet Liner is central in the Frame and sits correctly.
- 1f. Zip both Top Rail fabrics completely.
- 19. Secure the Bassinet to the Cross Brace using the 4 x Velcros located on the underside of the Bassinet.

# Cleaning

To ensure the long-lasting use of your bassinet, dry it with a soft absorbent cloth after use. Use a damp cloth to clean the frame. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Allow to dry completely before storing it away. Do not dry clean, or use bleach on fabrics or trims. Do not machine wash, tumble or spin dry, unless the care labelling on the product permits these methods.



Hand wash in cold water



DO NOT iron



DO NOT bleach



DO NOT dry clean



DO NOT tumble dry

#### Maintenance

Check bassinet regularly to ensure that locking devices and components are secure and working properly. Always check parts regularly for tightness of screws, nuts and other fasteners – tighten or replace if required. To maintain the safety of your bassinet, seek prompt repairs for bent, torn, worn or broken parts. Use only those parts and accessories approved by **CNP Brands**.


