Read all instructions before assembly and use of the travel cot. Keep instructions for future use.

⚠ WARNING ⚠

BEFORE ASSEMBLING THIS COT, READ AND UNDERSTAND THE INSTRUCTIONS.

Do not use mattress other than the one supplied by the manufacturer. Incorrect mattress can cause death.

Use only accessories as recommended by the manufacturer.

Ensure the top rails and base are fully locked.

Stop using this cot if any part of the cot is broken, torn or missing.

KEEP INSTRUCTIONS IN A SAFE PLACE FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.

Changer: weight limit 8 kg.

Bassinet: weight limit 8 kg.

Travel Cot: weight limit 13 kg.

Use only accessories as recommended by the supplier.

Ensure the top rails and base are fully locked.

Failure to follow warnings and instructions could result in serious injury or death.

DO NOT use your folding cot if any parts are torn, missing or broken.

Contact the manufacturer for replacement parts or instructions if they are required. Never use substitute parts.

Keep children away while assembling/disassembling the cot.

DO NOT leave anything on the folding cot (such as toys) that provide a foothold.

DO NOT use the folding cot near naked heat sources, bar heaters, open fires or exposed flames.

Keep the folding cot clear of trailing cables and hanging cords.

Keep medication and small items that a child could choke on, away from the cot.

DO NOT use the folding cot if fabric or padding on the side rails or end rails has been bitten through.

FALL HAZARD – To prevent falls, **DO NOT** use the folding cot once the infant has reached the manufacturer's maximum weight of 13kgs or a height of 85cm tall.

SUFFOCATION HAZARD – Infants can suffocate;

- In gaps between an extra pad or mattress.
- In soft bedding.

NEVER leave your child unattended.

Use this product with only one child at a time.

To reduce the risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS), paediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.





There are no accessories recommended for use with this Childcare Travel Cot.

To assemble Travel Cot...

- 1**
- 1a. Unzip bag.
 - 1b. Remove travel cot and stand unit upright.
 - 1c. Unhook Velcro tabs.
 - 1d. Remove mattress pad.



- 2**
- 2a. Separate tops of corner posts.
 - 2b. Ensure centre support is set to the highest position.



- 3**
- 3a. Grasp centre of each side and end rail, lift to 'snap' into correct position.
 - 3b. If 'snapping' of the side and end rail locks does not occur easily, recheck that the centre hub is raised to recommended height before proceeding.

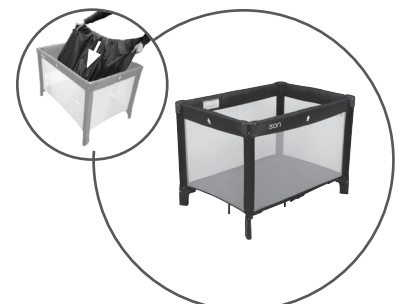


- 4**
- 4a. Press down on centre hub to lock it into position.
 - 4b. Check and ensure all the locking devices are fully engaged.
 - 4c. If not, lift the centre support and repeat steps 5 and 6.



IMPORTANT! Before pushing down centre hub into locked position, check that the support legs are positioned flat on the floor to successfully lock down the centre hub.

- 5**
- 5a. Lay mattress pad on the base of the travel cot, soft side up.
 - 5b. Fasten the Velcro to the cot base to secure mattress.
 - 5c. Check the assembly of the travel cot is correct and safe.



IMPORTANT! Check to ensure the travel cot frame is secure.

The travel cot is now ready for use.

To assemble Bassinet...

1

- 1a. Remove the mattress pad by unfastening the Velcro fasteners and remove the mattress.



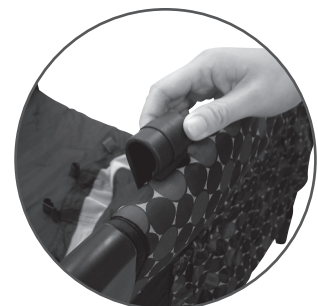
2

- 2a. Place bassinet on a flat surface with the sleeves facing up.
 2b. First, insert the closed ends of all four of the support tubes into the sleeves of the bassinet.
 2c. Next, fit the bassinet support tubes with the tapered ends into the bassinet support tubes with the open ends.
 2d. Fasten the additional four Velcro straps for extra security.



3

- 3a. With the bassinet support tubes facing down, insert the bassinet into the travel cot.
 3b. Fit 4 bassinet end clips over the travel cot short end rail.



4

- 4a. Repeat step 3a to attach the remaining bassinet side and end clips.
 4b. Please ensure Velcro is fastened on all corners to secure bassinet.

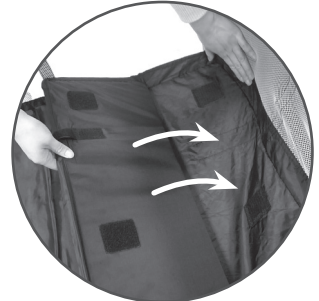
- 5a. Place the mattress pad into the bassinet.



To assemble Bassinet continued...

6

- 6a. Push down on the mattress pad to attach all the fasteners
- 6b. Ensure the Velcro is firmly in position.



⚠ WARNING ⚠

**This bassinet should be removed before the child can sit up.
Use only the mattress supplied by the manufacturer.
Incorrect mattress can cause death.
Never place a child in the cot when the bassinet is in place.**

The bassinet is now ready for use.

To assemble Changer...

1

1a. Open the changer and place on a flat surface.



2

2a. Assemble change table tubes ensuring the locking button is pushed down and tubes click into place.



3

3a. Your changer can be installed on either end of your travel cot by simply sliding the slotted clips over the fabric upper frame tube at one end of the travel cot.

3b. Then clip the four base clips downwards on both sides of the travel cot.



4

4a. Clip on remaining hooks on the sides of the cot as per image.

4b. Before use, make sure that the travel cot and changer are both tightly secured.

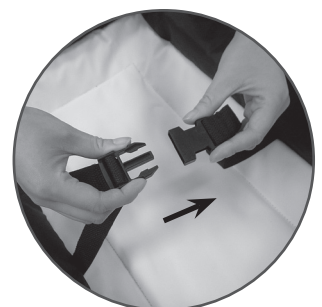

5a. After placing your child in the changer, position the waist belt around your child's waist.

5b. Fasten the waist belt. Make sure you hear a 'click'.

5c. Check to be sure the waist belt is securely attached by pulling it away from your child. The waist belt should remain attached.



To assemble Changer...

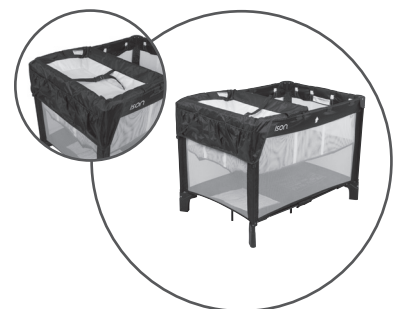
- 6
 - 6a. Tighten the waist belt so it is snug against your child.
 - 6b. To tighten the waist belt, feed the anchored end of the waist belt up through the buckle to form a loop.
 - 6c. Pull the free end of the waist belt.



- 7
 - 7a. To loosen the waist belt, feed the free end of the belt up through the buckle to form a loop.
 - 7b. Enlarge the loop by pulling on the end of the loop towards the buckle.
 - 7c. Pull the anchored end of the waist belt to shorten the free end of the waist belt.



- 8
 - 8a. When the changer is not in use the changer can be flipped over to rest against the side of the cot, as shown in image.



⚠ WARNING ⚠

Never leave child unattended.
Never place a child in the cot when the change table is in place.
Always use the harness when using the change table.

The changer is now ready for use.

To fold Travel Cot...

1

- 1a. Unfasten the Velcro fasteners from the cot base and remove mattress pad.



2

- 2a. Locate the centre hub inside the travel cot.
 2b. Twist and lift the handle to release the centre hub lock.
 2c. Lift centre hub, making sure it is raised to highest position.



3

- 3a. Lift latch (A), squeeze button in the centre of the side rail (B)
 3b. Gently push rail down (C).
 3c. Repeat to release latches on remaining three rail centres.

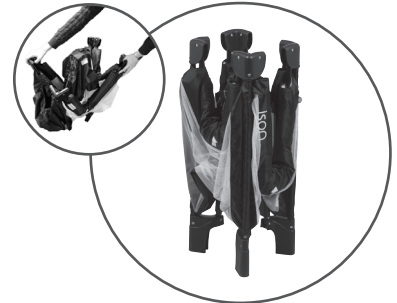


PLEASE NOTE! Latches will not release unless you lift up rail centre and squeeze the button at the same time.

To fold Travel Cot continued...

4

- 4a. Push all sides of travel cot in towards centre hub.
- 4b. Lay mattress pad on floor, soft side up, and lay travel cot on mattress pad.



5

- 5a. Wrap mattress pad around travel cot and fasten the Velcro tabs.



6

- 6a. Place travel cot into bag and zip together.
- 6b. The travel cot is now ready for easy carrying or storage.

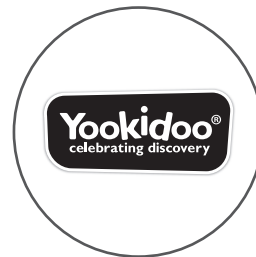


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
