# **A** WARNING **A**

BEFORE ASSEMBLING THIS TRAVEL COT, READ AND UNDERSTAND THE INSTRUCTIONS.

DO NOT USE MATTRESS OTHER THAN THE ONE SUPPLIED BY THE MANUFACTURER.

INCORRECT MATTRESS CAN CAUSE DEATH.

USE ONLY ACCESSORIES AS RECOMMENDED BY THE MANUFACTURER.

ENSURE THE TOP RAILS AND BASE ARE FULLY LOCKED.

DO NOT MOVE THE PRODUCT WITH THE CHILD INSIDE.

STOP USING THIS TRAVEL COT IF ANY PART OF THE COT IS BROKEN, TORN OR MISSING.

THIS BASSINET SHOULD BE REMOVED BEFORE CHILD CAN SIT UP.

NEVER PLACE A CHILD IN THE COT WHEN THIS BASSINET IS IN PLACE.

DO NOT ADD AN EXTRA MATTRESS AS THIS MAY CAUSE SUFFOCATION.

KEEP INSTRUCTIONS IN A SAFE PLACE FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.

Bassinet weight limit: **8 kg.**Travel Cot weight limit: **13 kg.** 

Use only accessories as recommended by the supplier.

Ensure the top rails and base are fully locked.

Failure to follow warnings and instructions could result in serious injury or death.

**DO NOT** use your folding cot if any parts are torn, missing or broken.

Contact the manufacturer for replacement parts or instructions if they are required. Never use substitute parts.

Keep children away while assembling/disassembling the cot.

**DO NOT** leave any object inside the product that could reduce it's depth.

**DO NOT** leave anything in the folding cot (such as toys) that provide a foothold.

**DO NOT** use the folding cot near naked heat sources, bar heaters, open fires or exposed flames.

Keep the folding cot clear of trailing cables and hanging cords.

Keep medication and small items that a child could choke on, away from the cot.

**DO NOT** use the folding cot if fabric or padding on the side rails or end rails has been bitten through.

**FALL HAZARD** – To prevent falls, **DO NOT** use the folding cot once the infant has reached the manufacturer's maximum weight of 13kgs or a height of 85cm tall.

Be aware of the risk of open fires and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar heaters, gas fires etc.

### **SUFFOCATION HAZARD** – Infants can suffocate:

- In gaps between an extra pad or mattress.
- In soft bedding.

**NEVER** leave your child unattended.

Use this product with only one child at a time.

To reduce the risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS), paediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.



# **A** WARNING **A**

SUFFOCATION HAZARD - INFANTS HAVE SUFFOCATED IN GAPS BETWEEN EXTRA PADDING AND SIDE OF BASSINET/CRADLE AND ON SOFT BEDDING.

USE ONLY THE PAD PROVIDED BY MANUFACTURER.

NEVER ADD A PILLOW, COMFORTER OR ANOTHER MATTRESS FOR PADDING.

**NEVER** leave your child unattended.

To prevent serious or fatal injury from falls always keep child within arm's reach.

If a sheet is used with the pad, use only the one provided by CNP Brands.

A bassinet is designed to provide a sleeping area for an infant until he or she begins to push up on hands and knees or approximately 5 months of age. Move your child to another sleeping product when your child reaches this stage.

**DO NOT** place product near a window where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.

Strings can cause strangulation! **DO NOT** place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings over a bassinet or cradle or attach strings to toys.

**DO NOT** allow children to climb or play on or under unit in any configuration.

**NEVER** use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers not sold and intended for that purpose. They can cause suffocation.

**SUFFOCATION HAZARD:** Discard all packing materials immediately after opening. Plastic bags and ties may cause suffocation or choking.

**FALL HAZARD:** To help prevent falls, do not use this bassinet when infant begins to push up on hands and knees or has reached manufacturer's recommended maximum weight of 8kgs, whichever comes first.







# To assemble Travel Cot Frame...



1b. Open the Travel Cot Frame and lay it down on a flat surface with the legs facing upwards.



2a. Lift one leg outwards.

2b. Whilst holding the leg, turn the leg locking ring clockwise until tight.

2c. Repeat for remaining three legs.



3a. When all legs are secured, stand the Travel Cot upright.



4a. Attach all four top corners of the liner to the legs of the **Travel Cot** using the press studs.



5a. Insert the Mattress on the diagonal into the **Travel Cot**.

5b. Twist the Mattress while letting it open and place into position on the base.

5c. The **Travel Cot** is now ready for use.





# To assemble Bassinet...



- 1a. Insert Bassinet inside Travel Cot.
- Align zipper on Bassinet with zip on inside of Travel Cot.
- 1c. Zip completely to secure.



The Bassinet is now ready for use.



# To attach Toy Bar...



- Align Toy Bar with Travel Cot top rail long sides.
- 1b. Push down on Toy Bar until it 'clicks' into place and is secure.



**CAUTION:** Never use the Toy Bar to lift the Travel Cot.

# To attach Toys...



- Feed Toy attachment rope up and through the pre-drilled hole in the Toy Bar to the desired length.
- 1b. Tie the end of the attachment rope into a knot to secure.
- 1c. Repeat for remaining two toys.



NOTE: Hanging toys are not intended to be mouthed by child.



# To Disassemble...



1a. Fold the Mattress toward the centre, lift and remove on the diagonal.





- 2a. Release press studs from Liner corners.
- 2b. Lay unit down with legs facing up.




- 3
- 3a. Turn the leg locking ring counter-clockwise to release leg.
- 3b. Carefully fold leg inwards.
- 3c. Repeat for remaining three legs.

- 4a. For the most compact fold, fold the left rear leg.
- 4b. Then fold the left front leg.



- 5
- 5a. Fold the right rear leg.
- 5b. And finally the right front leg.





## To Disassemble continued...



6a. To fold the Frame, slightly lift the frame on one end and press the large release buttons beneath the fabric on the inside of the Top Frame on both sides.



- 7
- 7a. Fold one side over to the other.
- 7b. Take care not to catch the legs against the mesh.



# To pack into Carry Bag...



- 1a. Fold the Mattress towards the centre and slide it into the Bag.
- 1b. Be sure that the flat side of the mattress when folded, slides in first.
- 1c. Slide the folded Cot between the mattress sides.
- 1d. Slide Bassinet, Toy Bar and Hanging Toys into the Carry Bag also.





2a. Zip the Carry Bag together.

# Cleaning

This product has been designed and developed with safety, comfort and functionality in mind. Please take the time to read this manual carefully before using this product and keep it in a safe place for future reference.

To ensure the long-lasting use of your bedside sleeper, do not use solvents, abrasives or aggressive cleaning products. After each wash check the resistance of the fabric and the stitching. For washing of the fabric, carefully comply with instructions indicated on the label.

### **Maintenance**

Always check parts regularly for tightness of screws, nuts and other fasteners – tighten or replace if required. On a regular basis check the condition of the product and presence of any possible damage. In the case of damage do not use and keep it out of the reach of children. To maintain the safety of your travel cot seek prompt repairs for bent, torn, worn or broken parts. Use only those parts and accessories approved by **CNP Brands.**
