A WARNING A

ADULT ASSEMBLY REQUIRED:

DUE TO THE PRESENCE OF SMALL PARTS DURING ASSEMBLY, KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN UNTIL ASSEMBLY IS COMPLETE. TO PREVENT FALLS, THE MATTRESS BASE OF THIS COT SHOULD BE ADJUSTED TO THE LOWEST POSITION BEFORE THE CHILD CAN SIT UP. RECOMMENDED MATTRESS SIZE: 960 MM LONG X 600 MM WIDE X 70 MM THICK. FOLLOW THE MANUFACTURER'S ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS TO ENSURE THE SAFETY FEATURES OF THE COT ARE NOT COMPROMISED.

Use only accessories as recommended by the supplier.

Failure to follow warnings and instructions could result in serious injury or death.

This cot has been manufactured for one child only, with a maximum weight of 18kgs. The drop side must be raised when the child is unsupervised.

When the mattress base is assembled in the lower position, ensure the higher cot base holes are covered tightly with the filling bolts supplied. This is to prevent finger entrapment, swallowing and inhalation hazards.

ENSURE the cot is placed at a reasonable distance from curtains, blinds, heaters and power points. **ENSURE** the cot is completely assembled and check that all parts are securely tightened before placing the child into the cot. ENSURE medication, string, elastic, small toys or small items such as money etc are always kept out of the child's reach when in the cot.

DO NOT over tighten bolts/screws.

ENSURE that the child is clear of any moving parts when

adjusting the cot. For warranty purposes, keep your sales

receipt to provide proof of purchase.

RECOMMENDED MATTRESS SIZE (SOLD SEPARATELY):

THIS COT HAS BEEN MANUFACTURED FOR USE WITH A MATTRESS WHICH MEASURES **960 MM LONG BY 600 MM WIDE AND70 MM INTHICKNESS**.

The width and length are specified because it is important that the gaps between the mattress and the sides and ends of the cot will not exceed 40 mm when the mattress is pushed to one side or end, and 20mm when the mattress is centred in the cot.

This is to minimise the risk of a child's limb becoming caught in the gap.

The thickness of the mattress has been specified to ensure that the depth of the cot is greater than 500 mm with the mattress base in the lower position to minimise the risk of a child climbing or falling out of the cot.

SUFFOCATION HAZARD- Infants can suffocate;

• In gaps between an extra pad or mattress.

• In soft bedding

To reduce the risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS), paediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.





- a. It is advisable that two people assemble the cot in the room in which it is to be used.
- b. As small parts are involved in assembly, children should be kept clear of the assembly area.
- c. Dispose of all packaging material immediately after the cot is assembled.
- d. Identify all parts and components.
- e. Clear an area on the floor for assembly and place a sheet on the floor to ensure the cot is not scratched during assembly.

A WARNING A

DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN BOLTS. OVER TIGHTENING BOLTS CAN CAUSE PANELS TO CRACK.

To assemble Cot...



1a. Attach 1 x Mattress Support Bolt into threaded hole on inside of 1 x End Panel.

 Repeat for remaining End Panel.
 (One End Panel screw hole will be on the left side. The other End Panel screw hole will be on the right side).



2a. Stand 1 x End Panel upright.

2b. Attach 1 x Side Panel to the End Panel (on the side that has the Mattress Support Bolt) using 2 x 35mm Cot Bolts.
Do not tighten bolts completely.

Attach the remaining End Panel to the Side Panel using 2 x 35mm Cot Bolts. Do not tighten bolts completely.







To assemble Cot continued...

Attach 2 x Latch Shafts into the threaded holes at both ends of the Mattress Base.

4b. Place and hold Mattress Base inside the Cot.

A WARNING A

MATTRESS BASE 'THIS SIDE UP' LABEL MUST BE FACING UPWARD WHEN MATTRESS BASE IS INSTALLED

- 4c. Align the 2 x Latch Shafts on the Mattress Base with the higher holes on the inside of the End Panels and insert into place.
- 4d. Carefully lower the Mattress Base down to rest on the Mattress Support Bolts.



- 5a. Attach the remaining Side Panel to the 2 x End Panels using 4 x 35mm Cot Bolts. Do not tighten bolts completely.
- 5b. Secure Mattress Base to both End Panels using 2 x 45mm Mattress Base Bolts.











To assemble Cot continued...



6a. Tighten all 8 x Cot Assembly Bolts and 2 x Mattress Base Bolts until fully secure.



- 7a. Place Cot down on a Side Panel.
- 7b. Insert 4 x Castors into Cot feet until secure.
- 7c. Stand Cot upright.

PLEASE NOTE: Castors can be locked by pushing down the locking tab on top of the castor. Lift locking tab to unlock castors.

Mattress Base Heights...

Mattress Base in High Position

Mattress Base in Low Position

The base height is set for when your baby is young and cannot sit up unaided.

This is the normal position for an active baby who can sit up unaided.

PLEASE NOTE: The cot comes with filling bolts already located in the lower holes of the end panels. If changing the mattress base from the upper to the lower position, you must swap over the filling bolts. It is important that the filling bolts are replaced into the opened holes. Ensure they are secured tightly with the allen key and check regularly that they do not loosen.

To adjust Mattress Base Height...



- 1a. Remove Mattress from the Cot.
- 1b. Remove the 2 x Mattress Base Bolts from the End Panels.
- 1c. Remove the 6 x Filler Bolts from the lower position on the End Panels.
- 2a. Lay Cot down on the Side Panel nearest to the Mattress Support Bolts.





Whilst holding the Mattress Base, carefully disconnect Mattress Base away from the End Panels and allow End Panels to Fold.

Remove 2 x Mattress Support Bolts and re-fit in the lower position.

Insert Mattress Base into Cot. 6a.

Unfold End Panels and insert Mattress Base 6b. Latch Shafts into Latch Shaft Holes in the End Panel.

NOTE: Take care to not let End Panels disconnect from Mattress Base, as it is not yet secure.

7a. Secure Mattress Base to End Panels using 2 x Mattress Base Bolts.

8a. Carefully stand Cot upright.

Re-attach Side Panel to End Panels using 4 x 35mm Cot Bolts.

To Fold Cot...

Remove 2 x 45mm Mattress Base Bolts.



Slowly and carefully lift side of Mattress Base and rotate to the fully upright position.

NOTE: Please take care when performing this step, to ensure Mattress Base does not scrape or damage the End Panels.



Push both End Panels in towards the centre of the Cot until fully folded.









Store Folded Cot, Mattress and Mattress Base Bolts in a safe place.



To Re-use Cot...

Push Cot Sides and Ends outward until the Cot shape is correctly formed.











Carefully lower the Mattress Base down and into position.

NOTE: Please take care when performing this step, to ensure Mattress Base does not scrape or damage the End Panels.



- 3a. Re-fit 2 x 45mm Mattress Base Bolts.
- 3b. Place Mattress inside the Cot.

Cleaning

This product has been designed and developed with safety, comfort and functionality in mind. Please take the time to read this manual carefully before using this product and keep it in a safe place for future reference.

To ensure the long-lasting use of your cot, wipe down with a damp cloth and use a mild soap solution if necessary. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Always store product in a clean dry place.

Maintenance

Always check parts regularly for tightness of screws, nuts and other fasteners – tighten or replace if required. To maintain the safety of your cot, seek prompt repairs for bent, torn, worn or broken parts. Use only those parts and accessories approved by **CNP Brands**.


