**Description:** This recall involves West Lake International's adult bicycle helmet models BH11 and H-103. The recalled helmets were sold in Green, Pink, Yellow, White, Red, and Blue and in size(s) Medium. The recalled helmets have black Nylon fabric straps with white striped patterns in the center and a black plastic knob at the back of the helmet for adjusting the fitting. Please note that the model number(s) are not visible on the helmets.
