

# Erratum

## Sirena Snood in SCUBA MERINO & MERINO 120

Our original Sirena Snood was written to be sold with Baby Cashmerino yarn by Debbie Bliss. We now sell this kit with our very own Scuba Merino (and occasionally Merino 120 by Lang Yarns) - they're both super soft, and a very similar weight.

However, the length of yarn in the ball is very slightly shorter than Baby Cash, so to make sure you don't run out of yarn, we've provided some amendments to the pattern below.

**Complete Section 1 of the pattern, and then follow Section 2 of the pattern to Row 58. Then, make the following changes:**

Row 59 (RS)            **Knit all stitches**

Row 60 (WS)           **Knit all stitches**

**Row 60 will create the row of purl bumps for the second fold.  
Change to colour A.**

Row 61 (RS)           **Knit all stitches**

Row 62 (WS)           **Purl all stitches**

Rows 63-106           **Repeat rows 61 & 62**

Row 107 (RS)         **Knit all stitches**

**Continue the pattern as advised from Section 3.**
