🤃 📢 DIY Easter Carrot Patch Recipe 🦫

Ingredients

- Box of brownie mix
- Chocolate Frosting
- Oreos
- Chocolate Candy Wafers
- Strawberries
- Orange food coloring
- Optional: edible grass decoration



Instructions

- 1. Select a base for your carrot patch. We chose brownies, but feel free to select your desired base. Other base suggestions: cookies, pudding cups, ice cream, cake.
- 2. Bake your brownies as instructed on the box.
- 3. After your brownies cool, use the container of chocolate icing and cover the brownies in an even layer.
- 4. Then, take your Oreos out of the package, separate the top and bottom, and remove the cream filling. Place Oreos inside a separate bag.
- 5. Once you have the desired amount of Oreos, crush them until they are even crumbs. They should look like dirt.
- 6. Spread an even layer of the crushed Oreos onto your icing layer.
- 7. Rinse your strawberries thoroughly, pat them dry.
- 8. Melt your candy wafers. If you are able to find orange wafers, this will work as well. If you have white wafers, once you melt your chocolates, add a few drops of orange food coloring. Mix thoroughly.
- 9. Dip your desired amount of strawberries into the melted wafers. Place on a tray lined with parchment paper and store in the refrigerator until they have hardened.
- 10. Once your strawberries are dry, arrange them on top of your Oreos until you have your desired look.
- 11. Optional: you may add edible grass or add green frosting around your strawberries.
