

# DIY Unicorn Snow Globe

## What you'll need:

- **Clear jars with lid** - any size and shape will do, as long as you still have the lid
- **Recycled caps** - from water bottles, baby food jars, etc
- **Mini plastic unicorn figurine** - you can pick out whatever kind you'd like, just make sure it is small enough to fit in your jar
- **Hot glue gun**
- **2 teaspoons of Glycerine**
- **Filtered water**
- **Your favorite color glitter**
- **Optional:**
  - Your favorite patterned or colored ribbon
  - Your favorite color paint
  - Paintbrush - ribbons



## Steps:

- 1 Using your paint and paintbrush, paint the lid of the jar you'll be using for your snowglobe. Let it dry.
- 2 Hot glue the recycled caps to the inside of the lid of your jar. This will help prop your unicorn up higher, making sure she's not sitting too low in the snow globe. You may need to use two lids to find the proper height. Let them dry in place.
- 3 Hot glue your unicorn figurine on top of the recycled lids. Set aside to dry.
- 4 Pour filtered water inside the jar, filling it to the top. Add just a little bit of glitter -- too much will clump -- and two teaspoons of glycerine.
- 5 Carefully screw the jar lid tightly shut.
- 6 **Optional:**
  - Add hot glue along the outside of the lid to prevent leaking.
  - Tie ribbon around the lid for extra glam!
