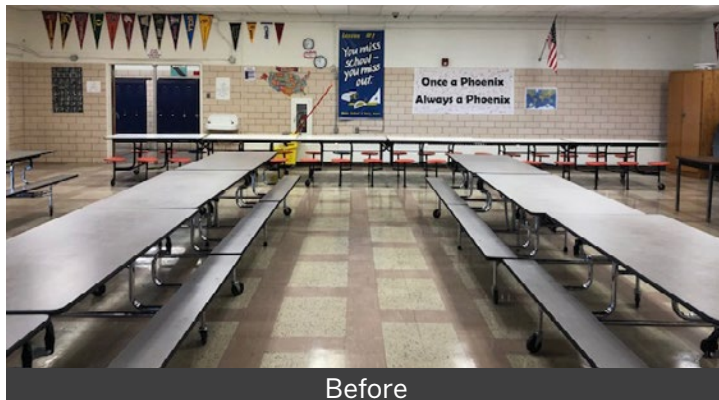


The Challenge
