


Huey wishes to "spear" a fish with a laser. Should he aim the laser beam above, below, or directly at the observed fish to make a direct hit?


Huey wishes to "spear" a fish with a laser. Should he aim the laser beam above, below, or directly at the observed fish to make a direct hit?



## Answer:

CONCEPTUAL Physics

Huey should aim directly at the fish he sees. If he were instead throwing a spear, he's have to compensate for the refraction of light and aim below the



observed fish. But not if the "spear" is a light beam! A light path is reversible, and will go from A to B along the same path it takes from B to A.
