FJ Cruiser GRILLE Decal Installation

Thank you for your order. Please read the installation instruction completely before applying your vinyl decals.

This installation should take about 30 minutes. Here is what you will need:

Small bowl Water Dish soap Masking Tape Soft towel

Proper cleaning and preparation of the surface prior to vinyl application is critical to the success of the decals. Thoroughly clean the surface of each letter with mild soap and water, making sure that all bug guts have been removed.

To ensure proper alignment of the decals over the TOYOTA letters on the grille, we recommend the "wet" application method.

- 1. Make a soap solution by filling a small bowl with water and adding several drops of dish.
- 2. Dip your finger in the soap solution and spread the solution over the T on the center cap, ensuring that the entire letter is wet.
- 3. Attach a small piece of masking tape to the top of the T decal and gently pull up to separate the vinyl from the paper backing. DO NOT get the backing paper wet. Doing so will prevent the decal from separating from the paper.
- 4. Dip the entire decal and tape in the soap solution.
- 5. Lay the decal over the T on the grille. It should "float" on the soap solution over the letter on the grille. The soap solution will help move the decal to the desired position before the decal adheres to the grille. DO NOT remove the tape yet.
- 6. Gently nudge the T into position with your fingers until it is centered over the letter. The tape will allow you to lift and reposition the decal, if necessary. Blot away any excess water with the soft towel to prevent the decal from moving too much. When you are satisfied with the position of the decal anchor one of the arms of the T with your thumb and slowly slide your other thumb over the decal to push out the water out from under the decal. Do this lightly at first to allow you to reposition the decal as needed as you squeegee it with your thumb. The vinyl will quickly adhere to the grille as the moisture is removed with each pass of your thumb so be sure it is positioned correctly. Once adhered to the grille the decal cannot be removed with destroying it.
- 7. Remove the masking tape by holding the decal adjacent to the tape and slowly peeling the masking tape off. Slide your finger over the decal where the tape was to remove any excess moisture.
- 8. Gently blot the excess moisture from the area with a soft towel and make several more gentle passes with your thumbs until there is no more moisture coming out from under the vinyl decal.
- 9. Repeat these steps for the remaining letters on the grille, applying the masking tape to the top of each letter.
- 10. After all the decal have been applied return to the first decal and use a bit more pressure with your thumbs to push out any remaining moisture then blot it with the soft towel. Repeat this final step on the remaining decals.

Please allow 24 hours for the vinyl decals to completely dry and properly adhere to the grille before washing your truck or getting the decals wet.
