GAUGE

20 stitches &
44 rows

per 4"/10 cm in Admix Front, Back,
and Sleeve Patterns on main
needle, after blocking

*Note: Each stripe of color is 2 rows.
Counting stripes may be easier than
counting distinct rows with this
stitch pattern.*

22 stitches

per 4"/10 cm in Garter Rib Pattern
on main needle, after blocking

*Note: Any row gauge for Garter Rib
Pattern will work, as long as the
stitch gauge is met; two different
needle sizes may be required to
achieve both gauges.*

Sample 1 is Size 3, Semi-Cropped with Long Sleeves, in Arbor *Thaw* (C1) & Dapple *Anchor* (C2). Modeled by Sadie (on cover), 5'9"/175.25 cm, with 8"/20.5 cm positive ease.

Sample 2 is Size 4, Classic with Half Sleeves, in Arbor *Butte* (C1) & Dapple *Blueprint* (C2). Modeled by Sadie (on page 2) with 14"/35.5 cm positive ease.

REQUIRED TOOLS



Main
needle

Suggested Size: US 5 (3.75 mm)

- One 32" (80 cm) circular needle or straight needles as preferred



Ribbing
needle

Suggested Size: US 3 (3.25 mm)

Two or three sizes smaller than main needle

- One 32" (80 cm) circular needle or straight needles as preferred for hem and cuff ribbing
- One 16" (40 cm) circular needle or set of double pointed needles (DPNs) for neckband



Markers +
Notions

- Four removable/locking stitch markers (for marking reference points in fabric)
- Blunt tapestry needle
- One closed-ring stitch marker
