130 yards (119 meters) per 45g skein – DK weight wool yarn



OR

Brooklyn Tweed **Arbor**

145 yards (132 meters) per 50g skein – DK weight wool yarn

Please note: Underlined skein counts are near to the exact yardage for these sizes. Consider adding an extra skein.

Yardage is calculated with optional body shaping. If optional body shaping is not worked, an additional 15-30 yards/13-28 meters of yarn will be needed for each size.

Sample 1 is Size 2, Cropped Version with half sleeves in Re•Ply Rambouillet color *Barely There*. Modeled by Jouri (on page 2), 5'7½"/171.5 cm tall, with 4½"/11.5 cm positive ease.

Sample 2 is Size 2, Classic Version with long sleeves and optional shaping in Arbor color *Butte*. Modeled by Alexandra (on page 13), 5'4"/162.5 cm tall, with 3"/7.5 cm positive ease and Nico (on page 3), 5'11"/180.5 cm tall, with 4"/10 cm positive ease.

Sample 3 is Size 3, Classic Version, sleeveless in Re•Ply Rambouillet color *No Filter*. Modeled by Alexandra (on page 8), 5'4"/162.5 cm tall, with 4"/10 cm positive ease.

Sample 4 is Size 4, Tall Version with long tall sleeves in Re•Ply Rambouillet color *Silhouette*. Modeled by Alexandra (on page 2), 5'4"/162.5 cm tall, with 7"/18 cm positive ease and Nico (on page 10), 5'11"/180.5 cm tall, with 8"/20.5 cm positive ease.

REQUIRED TOOLS



Main needles

Suggested size US 4 (3.5mm)

- 16"/40 cm circular needle* for sleeves
- 32"/80 cm circular needle (or longer as preferred) for body
- Double-pointed needles (DPNs)*

Note: A different needle size may be required to achieve stated gauge working in the round versus working flat, due to individual variations in work. Be sure to swatch for both circular and flat brioche to determine required needle size(s); see tutorial for Speed Swatching for Circular Knitting listed in Resources.



Ribbing needles

Suggested size US 3 (3.25mm)

One or two sizes smaller than Main needle, for working ribbed trims

- 16"/40 cm circular needle* for neckband
- 32"/80 cm circular needle (or longer as preferred) for body
- DPNs*

**32"/80 cm or longer circular needle may be used instead if using Magic Loop method for working small circumferences in the round.*



Markers + Notions

- closed-ring stitch markers (one in a unique appearance for BOR)
- removable/locking stitch markers (for marking reference points in fabric)
- blunt tapestry needle
