Note: When viewing the fabric from the WS, there will be one visible knit stitch for every 2 rows worked, or 20 countable rows/rounds over 4"/10 cm.

Sample 1 is size 3, Semi-Cropped Version with Classic Sleeves in Shelter *Snowbound*. Modeled by Joui (on page 1), 5'7½"/171.5 cm tall, with 12"/30.5 cm positive ease; and Kyra (on page 2), 5'4"/162.5 cm tall, with 12"/30.5 cm positive ease.

Sample 2 is size 3, Classic Version with Classic Sleeves in Imbue *Cloak*. Modeled by Kyra (on page 2), 5'4"/162.5 cm tall, with 12"/30.5 cm positive ease.

REQUIRED TOOLS



Main needles

Suggested size US 6 (4 mm)

- 32"/80 cm circular needle (or longer as preferred)
- Double-pointed needles (DPNs)*



Ribbing needles

Suggested size US 4 (3.5 mm)

Two or three sizes smaller than Main needle, for working ribbed trims

- 32"/80 cm circular needle (or longer as preferred)
- DPNs*

**32"/80 cm or longer circular needle may be used instead if using Magic Loop method for working small circumferences in the round.*



Markers + Notions

- 6 closed-ring stitch markers, one in a unique appearance to indicated BOR
- stitch holders or waste yarn
- blunt tapestry needle
- either sewing needle and embroidery thread, or matching sock yarn for tacking down inner band
- removable/locking stitch markers (optional, for tracking decreases as they are worked)
- 4 buttons in desired size or a clasp closure (optional)
