

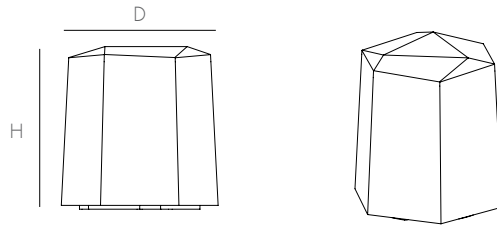


SUGAR STOOL

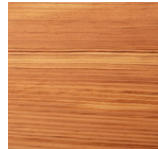
Our Sugar Stools start with sourcing reclaimed wood beams. A CNC machine then precision-cuts a faceted hexagonal design into the top end of the beam. The beam is cut down length-wise to sections, revealing a unique finish that naturally transitions from the pristine angles of the seat to the rough-hewn base. The name comes from our original Sugar Stools, created from reclaimed pine beams salvaged from Brooklyn's original Domino Sugar Refinery. - Chain-sawn sides
