We are responsible for sending you the ring size you ordered, but we cannot be responsible for defining your ring size. Please measure carefully, the final size remains your responsibility.

Different countries have different ring-size systems. The ISO standard for ring sizes defines ring sizes in terms of the inner circumference of the ring measured in millimeters. Remember: your hands are not equal. If a ring suits you fine on your right hand, it doesn't mean it will fit your left and vice versa.

If you need to know your size or if you are buying a gift, please use our rings size calculator following the instructions below. You can also contact us to get general assistance or if your size doesn't appear in this sizing guide. To buy with confidence we always recommend having your finger sized by a jeweller.

To determine your ring size, print this page and simply match one of the circles with the inside edge of your ring, preferably a wedding band or any simple shape sitting flat on the paper. Please make sure that your paper size is «A4» and that your printer has no scaling selected. The rulers below are made to check if your print is correct.
