## GEMONDO

If you do not know your ring size, the most accurate way to find it is to have your ring size measured at a jewellers. However, here is a guick quide.

First, print out this page on your printer.


To print this ring size chart and measurer to the correct dimensions, make sure that your printer is not set to "scale page to paper size". (It might say 100% scale - which is correct) You can verify that the page printed correctly by measuring the scale markers with a ruler; they should measure 14 centimeters across (as indicated).

Once you have printed the sizer and the measuring strip, you can either:

- 1. Place a ring that fits you on the circles, until you find one where the pink circle fits exactly inside the ring, or;
- 2. Cut out the measuring strip, wind it round your finger, and read off the letter that shows when the strip is comfortable (Don't make it too tight better to be slightly loose);
- 3. Take a ring that you know fits you well, and carefully measure across the inside of the ring, in millimeters. There is a conversion chart on the Gemondo website that shows you what that size will be in U.K. ring sizes, as well as U.S. and European sizes.
