This gift contains everything a farmer needs to start planting and producing their own food. Right now, this is lifesaving. COVID-19 has made it even harder for people across Zimbabwe to feed their families. One of the key ways to help is by giving people the skills and tools to grow their own food and survive the current crisis.

Each kit contains a variety of small grain seed packs containing sorghum and millet which are nutritious and a good source of protein and fibre. Along with the seeds, a farmer will also receive all the training and knowledge they need to turn these seeds into a sustainable source of food.
