Working parts of these fine releases are surface treated to incredible hardness that virtually eliminates wear at contact points. Due to the materials used, your Hot Shot release will function even more smoothly over time.

NANO-POST CINCH-POST

In order to keep your release working smoothly or if the trigger becomes sticky or does not move freely, we recommend you periodically:

- 1. Spray out your release using a gun scrubber or other cleaner that does not leave a residue.
- 2. Place a few drops of synthetic lubricant on the moving linkage areas.
- 3. Wipe off any excess oil.





Adjusting release length

- 1. Loosen hex screws aproximatly 1-1/2 turns.
- 2. Slide release post to desired length.
- 3. Tighten hex screws. DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN The lock washers will ensure the cap screws do not become loose.

Adjusting trigger tension The release can be set to a "hair-trigger" setting or higher tension settings.

Note: The factory setting for trigger tension is near "hair-trigger"



Using a 3/32 hex key, turn set screw clockwise to decrease tension (toward hair-trigger) & counter-clockwise to increase tension.

After each adjustment, shoot your bow with the release. You will not feel any change except with shooting your bow.

WARNING! Exercise extreme caution-trigger tension can be set so lightly that the
release will "go off" prematurely while
drawing the bow.
