Basic Packing Pouch \$12

- Minimal; designed to be pinned inside underwear at the waistband
- Not STP compatible
- Packer fully enclosed in pouch
- Available in black or white

Pouch with elastic tab on top for pinning.
Comes with safety pin. One size.



Basic Packing Jock \$15

- Jock-style, can be worn by itself or with underwear
- Not STP compatible
- Packer fully enclosed in pouch
- Available in black or white

XS: 25-27, S: 28-31, M: 32-35, L: 36-39,
XL: 40-43, 2XL: 44-47, 3XL: 48-52
(waist measure in inches)



Tool Belt \$28

- Jock-style, can be worn by itself or with underwear
- STP compatible
- Hole in the front for the packer's shaft to pass through, with a special sleeve to help prevent shaft pop-out
- Available in black or white

XS: 25-27, S: 28-31, M: 32-35, L: 36-39,
XL: 40-43, 2XL: 44-47, 3XL: 48-52
(waist measure in inches)



Slingshot Soft Harness \$22.00

- Designed to be worn around the thighs; no waistband, only leg bands
- STP compatible; designed specifically to work with Model D, Model A, or Model D Sport, though other packers can work with this harness
- Two holes in the front: one for the shaft, and one for the balls
- Back is open, leaving the packer's back exposed against the body

S: 28-32, M: 32-36, L: 36-42, XL: 42-48
(sizing based on approximate waist size in inches)



NYTC STP Harness \$24.00

- Designed to be worn around the thighs; no waistband, only leg bands
- STP compatible. Designed specifically to work with Sam the STP, though other packers can work with this harness
- Hole in the front for the shaft, with two small straps to dress shaft up or down
- Back is open, leaving the packer's back exposed against the body
- Latex free elastic

XXS: 14-15, XS: 16-18, S: 19-21, M: 22-24, L: 25-28,
XL: 29-32, XXL: 33-37
(sizing based on upper thigh circumference in inches)



Mr. Right Packing Strap/Jock \$18, \$23

- Made of a leather backer sewn to an elastic waistband. Jock style version includes elastic leg straps
- Not STP compatible
- Packer is held against leather backer in front by a T-shaped elastic "seatbelt"
- Works best with Mr. Right; softer packers can droop in front



XS: 26-30, S: 30-34, M: 34-38, L: 38-42, XL: 42-46, 2XL: 46-50, (waist measure in inches)

PS Packing Underwear \$17.50 & \$19.50

- Underwear to which we have added a basic pouch inside
- Not STP compatible
- Packer fully enclosed in pouch
- Available in Brief and Boxer Brief styles



S: 28-30, M: 31-33, L: 34-36, XL: 37-39 (waist measure in inches)

Pete Packing Underwear \$26.95, \$28.95, \$34.95 & \$35.95

- Designed specifically for soft packing
- STP compatible (Commando style is easiest to use with most STPs)
- Available in 4 styles: Commando, Freestyle, Briefs, and Trunks
- Commando style has the shaft hanging free in front
- Other styles have a layer of material covering the shaft at the fly front
- All styles have material layer inside to keep packer from touching skin



S: 28-30, M: 32-34, L: 36-38, XL: 40-42, 2XL: 44-46, 3XL: 48-50 (waist measure in inches)

Packer Gear Harness \$23, \$25 & \$27

- Underwear/harness designed to hold a soft packer or small dildo
- STP compatible
- Reinforced O-ring in the front for the packer's shaft to pass through
- Available in brief or boxer brief styles
- Both styles have material layer inside to keep packer from touching skin



XS/S: 27-39, M/L: 30-33, L/XL: 36-40 (waist measure in inches)

RodeoH Truhk Pouch Front STP/Packer Boxer \$29.99

- Designed specifically for packing and STP
- Built-in pouch/o-ring system to keep packer in place
- Open horizontal front pouch gives access for STP
- Very soft bamboo/ spandex blend



XS: 27-29, S: 30-32, M: 33-35, L: 36-38, XL: 39-41, 2X: 42-45
(waist measure in inches)

RodeoH Strap-On Harnesses (for pack and play) \$49 & \$50

- Underwear/harness designed to hold a small-to-medium dildo for play, but can also be used for soft packing
- Some designs are STP compatible
- Reinforced hole in the front for the packer's shaft to pass through
- One design has a working button fly, which can be used to keep the packer shaft contained
- Available in brief or boxer brief styles
- Most people buy these as a strap-on harness (due to their more expensive price), but they can also double as comfortable packing underwear
- Material layer inside to keep the packer from touching skin
- Color choices vary
- All sizes may not be available in all colors

Tomboii Brief Harness (for pack and play) \$84.95

- Underwear/harness designed to hold a dildo for play, but can also be used for soft packing
- STP compatible
- Reinforced hole in the front for the packer's shaft to pass through
- Most people buy these as a strap-on harness (due to their more expensive price), but they can also double as comfortable packing underwear
- Material layer inside to keep the packer from touching skin
- Inner vibe pockets for additional stimulation
- In black or red



XS: 26-28, S: 29-32, M: 33-37, L: 38-40, XL: 41-44, 2X: 45-48, 3X: 49-52
(waist measure in inches)

Tomboii Boxer Harnesses (for pack and play) \$109.95

- Underwear/harness designed to hold a dildo for play, but can also be used for soft packing
- STP compatible
- Two reinforced holes in the front for the packer's shaft to pass through; you can choose which is more comfortable
- Fly front to cover holes for shaft
- Most people buy these as a strap-on harness (due to their more expensive price), but they can also double as comfortable packing underwear
- Material layer inside to keep the packer from touching skin
- Inner vibe pockets for additional stimulation
- Black (second photo shows Tomboii inside out to illustrate inner design)

What to look for when choosing a packing harness

Here are a few points to consider when choosing a packing harness:

1. Will I be using an STP-packer or non-STP packer?

If you are using an Stand-To-Pee (STP) packer, keep in mind that you'll have to be able to access the funnel or other area where you pee into the packer. Choose a packing solution that gives you easy access to use your STP in a comfortable manner, and also allows you to wear it comfortably throughout the day.

2. Will I be wearing the harness inside my own underwear, or do I want packing underwear with a pouch or rings already built in?

Some harnesses are designed to be minimal, like jock straps or pouches that you can pin inside any underwear. Other solutions are "regular" underwear with secure packing systems built in. Size and styling may limit your choices for packing underwear. (If you can sew, you can add pouches to your own underwear at home!)

3. How delicate is my soft packer? How heavy/big is it?

Some soft packers are more delicate than others, especially where the shaft of the packer meets the balls. If your packer is prone to tearing, you might want to choose a packing solution that keeps your packer fully enclosed inside a pocket, rather than letting the shaft hang free through a ring or an opening in the harness.

Some packers are quite heavy, have shafts that are thick, or balls that are large (this is true of some pack-and-play style items). Choose a harness that is equipped to handle the size/weight of your packer.

4. How active do I plan to be?

Secure packing is important for not only avoiding packer damage, but also so you don't lose your packer accidentally during activities like contact sports, running, or swimming. Some people use different packing solutions for sports than they do for everyday packing.

5. How much contact do I want between the packer and my skin?

Depending on the material your packer is made of, direct skin contact may prove to be hot, uncomfortable, or irritating during everyday wear. Some harnesses keep a layer of fabric between you and the packer, which can help if you are prone to irritation.
