Cookie Decorating Collages



Hello and Happy Decorating!

This document contains a collage with the decorating steps from the Valentine's 2023 Cookie Cutter release. I hope this is helpful as you decorate these cookies!

Each Collage shows a feature photo and then the step-by-step process photos. A collage of the mini cookies is also included in this guide. They are a bit repetitive, but a few of the steps on the minis vary (are simpler) than the larger version of the same design. To create these collages, it requires hundreds of photos to be taken. As a result a few photos are missed. In that case a note is made on the collage page and a written instruction is provided.

I have provided a list of the icing colors used in each set's palette. Unless otherwise noted, royal icing colors are used in both a piping and flooding icing consistency. I used a tip #2 on the piping bags for outlines and details. If I used a different tip, I made a note on the collage page!



Just My Type Cutter Set





Just My Type Icing Colors: Red (mix Super Red + Rose Pink), Dark Rose Pink, Light Rose Pink, White, Turquoise, and Black Diamond (pipe only)



Typewriter



I used PME tip #1.5 with the black to keep the lettering small. I used pink flood to add the keys 'dots' on the keyboard.

Puckered Lips



Collage note: The photo for step #2 is not pictured. In this step, the bottom lip was flooded.

I used tip #3 on the spiral binding.

MINI Just My Type Cutters







Just My Type Icing Colors: Red (Super Red + Rose Pink), Dark Rose Pink, Light Rose Pink, White, Turquoise, and Black Diamond (pipe only)

Collage note: The photo for step #1 is not pictured. In this step, the bottom of the typewriter was outlined. See page 4 for similar steps with the regular sized cookie.

Eggs and Bacon Color Palette:

Sky Blue, Bacon (Dark Tulip Red + Brown), Bacon



(Light Tulip Red + Brown) flood only, White, Golden Yellow (flood only), and Black Diamond



Chips and Guac Color Palette: Gray (flood not in photo, but required), Avocado (pipe only), Ivory, Super Red, Bright White (flood only), and Black Diamond



Mac and Cheese Color Palette:

Black Diamond, Macaroni (Golden Yellow + Buckeye Brown), Gold, Light Golden Yellow (flood only), Dark Golden Yellow (flood only) Purple, Bright White (flood only)



Cookies and Milk Color Palette:

Sky Blue, White, Light Buckeye Brown, Dark Buckeye Brown (20-second), Black Diamond, Bakers Rose

*The Black and White colors are included in each icing palette to add faces to the cookies. If you're keeping the cookie plain (no face), omit the black and white.

Chips and Guac



I used the Hearts and Dots stencil with the Chefmaster silver airbrush color to add the pattern on the bowl.

I mixed a dot of Buckeye Brown gel with the Sugar Art Color Solution to flick specks onto the tortilla chip. I used a small PYO brush. Wear a glove to keep your hands clean.

Eggs and Bacon Color Palette:

Sky Blue, Dark Bacon (Tulip Red + Brown), Light Bacon (Tulip Red + Brown flood only), White, Golden Yellow (flood only), and Black Diamond



Chips and Guac Color Palette: Gray (flood not in photo, but required), Avocado (pipe only), Ivory, Super Red, Bright White (flood only), and Black Diamond



Mac and Cheese Color Palette:

Black Diamond, Macaroni (Golden Yellow + Buckeye Brown), Gold, Light Golden Yellow (flood only), Dark Golden Yellow (flood only) Purple, Bright White (flood only)



Cookies and Milk Color Palette:

Sky Blue, White, Light Buckeye Brown, Dark Buckeye Brown (20-second), Black Diamond, Bakers Rose

Mini Chips and Guac



I used the Hearts and Dots stencil with the Chefmaster silver airbrush color to add the pattern on the bowl.

Cupid Icing Colors: Dark Rose Pink, Light Rose Pink, Bright White, Turquoise, Black Diamond (pipe only), Leaf Green (pipe only), Buckeye Brown, Pastel Golden Yellow, and Sienna (20-second)



Cupid



I used tip #1 for the black lines to keep those details smaller.



Bow and Arrow



I used tip #1 for the black lines to keep that detail smaller.



Double Heart with Arrow





Bouquet



I used Wilton Tip #352 for the leaves.



Mini Cupid Love Cutter Set





Cupid Icing Colors: Dark Rose Pink, Light Rose Pink, Bright White, White, Turquoise, Black Diamond (pipe only), Leaf Green (pipe only), Buckeye Brown, Pastel Golden Yellow, and Sienna (20-second)



Mini Cupid



Collage note: The photo for step #3 is not pictured. In this step, Cupid's hair, clothes, and wings are flooded in.



Mini Bow and Arrow, Bouquet, and Double Heart with Arrow



Collage note: The photo for step #1 and step #2 for the Double Heart is not pictured. In step 1, the heart is outlined. In step 2, the dark pink heart is flooded. See page 28 for similar steps with the regular sized cookie.

I used tip #18 for the larger flowers on the bouquet. I used tip #13 for the small flowers. I used tip #352 for the leaves.



Panda Cutter Set





Panda Icing Colors: Black Diamond (pipe only), Charcoal (made with black diamond), Dark Fuchsia, Light Fuchsia, and Bright White. A purple Foodoodler Marker was used to draw the lines on the note.



Panda Mug



The panda eyes are a wet-on-wet-on-wet. Using flood icing, add the charcoal ovals, then a dot of white, and then one more tiny dot of charcoal.

Then you're ready to flood in the white head completely.



Panda with Balloon











Collage note: The photo for step #2 is not pictured. In this step, the panda body is outlined.

I used a tip #1 on the balloon string to keep that detail small.



Panda with Note



Collage note: The photo for step #3 is not pictured. In this step, the panda's body is flooded in.

This cookie features the purple Foodoodler marker. I suggest waiting 4-6 hours before drawing on the lines so you don't poke through the surface.



Panda with Heart



Collage note: The photo for step #2 is not pictured. In this step, the panda is outline.

Worried about color bleeding between the black and white? Add white food color to your icing before your make your colors. This will keep your colors solid even if the touch! Also just bump color up against each other, but don't 'inject' or push into the neighboring color. This can result in blurriness or color bleeding.
