Cast-in-Concrete Pipe Sleeve

Description:

The Cast in Concrete Pipe Sleeves are a circular metal collar with an Intumescent lining. Designed for setting into concrete and to allow any type of services (Cables, Pipes, etc) to be inserted or removed at anytime.

The sleeve has removable end caps made from acoustic sponge and fire proof card but can be cut with a sharp knife to accommodate services up to the internal diameter of the sleeve.

They can be fitted into bored holes if new services are required after the concrete has been set.

The Sleeve is suitable for use in either domestic or industrial applications (such as computer rooms, hospitals, laboratories, etc).

Material Specification:

The Cast in Concrete Pipe Sleeves are made from a metal casing lined with Intumescent material with end caps made from Fire card and Acoustic sponge.

Fire Card is not considered to have COSHH regulation status so therefore this product is made in a conventional papermaking process using the formulation of bleached wood pulp. The paper contains approximately 15 – 20% flame retardant chemicals.
