### **Expert Tip**

For small items, cut a glue dot in half before removing the backing paper



Tear a glue dot from the sheet and peel off one side of the backing paper.



Peel away the backing paper, trying not to touch the glue dot.

Pull the backing paper to the side, not upwards.



Push the glue dot onto the block.

Push hard to help it stick to the wood.



Firmly push the items you want to stick together.

For larger items, use multiple glue dots



## Hello makers! We hope you have a fantastic time sanding, building and decorating your Pick-Up Truck. Let's get making!

#### What's in the kit:









Before you start, fold your piece of sandpaper into thirds.

This makes it easier to hold on to.

Sand the sharp edges of **all** your blocks, including the headlights, exhaust pipes etc.

Hold the sandpaper at a 45° angle to the edge you are sanding for the best result.



We're looking for nice smooth edges so be as thorough as you can!



Always sand in the same direction as the grain lines in the wood. This avoids ugly scratch marks!







Before sticking, position the main components on the base and check you are happy with the layout.







Using glue dots, stick the engine block to the front of the base.

Sand a flat spot to the bottom of the headlights and stick them to the front of the base, either side of the engine block.



Stick the engine exhaust pipes to the sides of the block.

For small pieces, cut a glue dot in half before removing the backing paper.



Stick on the cab directly behind the engine block, then stick the exhaust pipes to the back of the cab.

Stick the truck bed onto the back of the base.



Prepare the wheels; push a screw through the centre hole and place a washer over the screw.

Screw the wheels into the holes on the base. Turn the screwdriver to the right (clockwise) to tighten. Be careful not to over-tighten the screws, the wheels should still move.


The rhyme 'Righty tighty, lefty loosey' helps us remember which way to turn!
