How to make a

Mason jar arrangement

You will need:

Tray

Flowers and foliage – use seasonal blooms that match your décor

Small vases, jars, bottles, also you can use egg cups, cups, jugs – whatever you have at home

For decoration – twine, ribbon, dried flowers, raffia, glue

Scissors




Gather all your clean jars, small vases, jugs, bottles if you want you can add egg cups or cups. Try to get a variety of sizes and heights.



Arrange all your jars, small vases or little bottles on the tray. Place tall bottles or vases at the back and smaller ones at the front.



Decorate your jars with twine, ribbon, burlap and lace. For a more permanent feature, use a glue gun to stick the fabric and lace to the vases. Alternatively, wrap the twine around the container and finish with a knot or a bow - try tying in a stem of lavender here and there.



Fill each of your containers with water.



Choose your flowers – for this arrangement it's best to use seasonal flowers. Select your favourites, cut off any foliage that will be underwater and trim your stems at an angle.



Start to arrange your flowers in the jars or vases, don't be afraid to use single stems. You could also add some herbs, blossoms or foliage from your garden.
