Organisational Structure & Operations

NIXI Body supplies absorbent underwear for leaks and periods.

As an SME we deal with a limited number of suppliers, services, marketing and Public Relations.

The vast majority of our suppliers are based in the UK and we have one overseas supplier. Our overseas supplier has been assessed by GIC and complies with ISO9001:2015 and has BSCI certification.

Actions we have taken.

- Made all staff aware of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and informed them of the appropriate action to take if they suspect a case of slavery or human trafficking.
- Will require up to date certification from our Main overseas supplier to confirm their processes and mechanisms for guarding against modern slavery.

We are committed to ensuring that slavery and human trafficking have no place in our business and in our supply chain.

This statement was approved by Director of NIXI Body and will be reviewed annually.

This statement is made pursuant to Section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes NIXI Body Limited's Slavery and Human Trafficking statement for the financial year ending 31st November 2023
