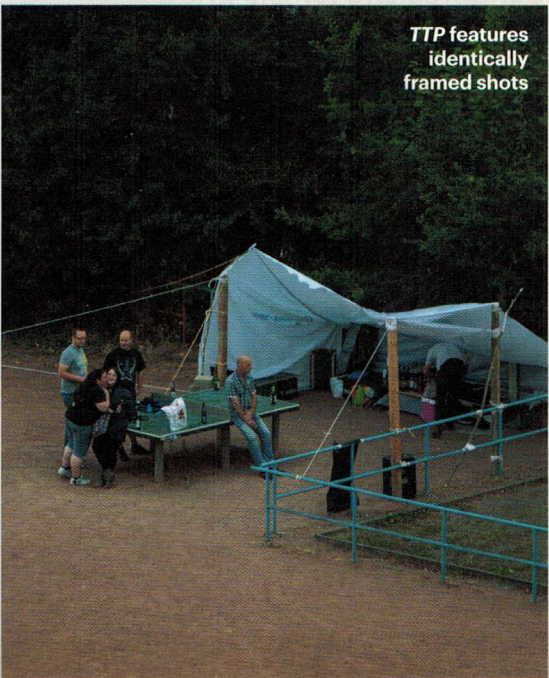
Foxy visit inspires book award winner



While studying in Germany, Japanese photographer Hayahisa Tomiyasu glanced out of his bedroom window and spotted a white fox sniffing around a ping-pong table in the park. Over the following days he monitored the table, waiting for the fox to return. It never did.

Instead, he started to document the varied life of the table, an object used for different purposes by different people: as a picnic table, a sun lounger, a climbing frame and, occasionally, for ping-pong.

TTP, Tomiyasu's simple but illuminating project, has won the 2018 MACK First Book Award.
