

### **POWER UP**

- 1. Insert 3-AA batteries into your Atomic Clock.
- 2. Complete Basic Settings.



### WWVB ATOMIC TIME SIGNAL

- After an initial search, the clock will automatically search for the WWVB Atomic Time Signal at UTC 7:00, 8:00, 9:00, 10:00, and 11:00.
- The Atomic Time Signal Icon be solid when connected.
- Hold the WAVE/+ button anytime, to manually search for the Atomic Time Signal.

### TIME ZONE

• Slide the Time Zone Switch on the back to your correct time zone: EST = Eastern, CST = Central, MST = Mountain, PST = Pacific

### DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME INDICATOR

- Hold the DST button to activate or deactivate the DST Indicator.
- The letters DST will show above the seconds to indicate the indicator is on, and the clock will automatically change for Daylight Saving Time.

### **FAHRENHEIT OR CELSIUS**

• Hold the °C/°F button to select Fahrenheit or Celsius temperature display.

### TIME ALARM

### **Set Alarm Time:**

- 1. Press the **SET** button to view Alarm Time. "**AL**" will show.
- 2. While viewing alarm time, hold the **SET** button to enter the Alarm Settings.
- 3. Press the WAVE/+ or DST/- button to adjust values.
- 4. Press the **SET** button to confirm and exit.

### Activate/Deactivate Alarm:

- 1. Press the **SET** button to view Alarm Time. "AL" will show.
- 2. Press the WAVE/+ or DST/- button activate or deactivate alarm.
- 3. The Alarm Icon  $\triangle$  will show when active.

**Snooze:** When alarm sounds, press the **SNOOZE** button to silence alarm for five minutes. The Snooze Icon will flash.

Note: Press any button except SNOOZE to stop a sounding alarm or exit Snooze Mode. The alarm will remain active for the next day.
