What: More than 800,000 school-aged children attend student nutrition programs across the province¹. Until today, these students have not had a platform to collectively shape them, including in their own circles.

Through a first of its kind 'Agents of Change Summit' #AOCSummit, (11) student Ambassadors, representing student nutrition agencies from across the province, will meet with leaders from the consumer goods and retail industry alongside issue stakeholders. The focus of the Summit will be on exploring ways to engage youth from across the province in the pressing issue of student nutrition and related awareness building. The event is part of the #Toonies4Tummies fundraising program underway across the province.
