TO MAKE A JOURNEY STICK ALL YOU NEED IS A STICK AND SOME STRING OR YARN...

NEXT TIME YOU'RE ON A WALK, LOOK FOR NATURAL OBJECTS THAT YOU FIND INTERESTING AND SIMPLY TIE THEM ONTO YOUR STICK. TRY FEATHERS, FLOWERS, ROCKS AND LEAVES, JUST REMEMBER TO BE MINDFUL ABOUT LOOKING AFTER NATURE AND ONLY COLLECT THINGS THAT HAVE FALLEN TO THE GROUND.

(PARENTS, YOUNGER EXPLORERS CAN USE A PIECE OF CARDBOARD WITH DOUBLE SIDED TAPE ATTACHED TO STICK THEIR NATURAL TREASURES TO).

NATURAL MEDICINI

IF YOU GET STUNG BY A STINGING
NETTLE, JUST FIND A DOCK LEAF AND
RUB IT ON THE STING.

CAMP FIRE RECIPES

COOKING ON A CAMPFIRE IS FUN AND SUPER EASY! HERE ARE TWO RECIPES TO TRY

CAMPFIRE BREAD WHAT YOU'LL NEED

500g Self-Raising Flour A Pinch of Salt 300-500ml Water



HOW TO COOK IT

- 1. PUT THE FLOUR AND SALT INTO A REUSABLE PLASTIC AIR-TIGHT BAG.
- 2. SLOWLY ADD THE WATER TO THE BAG AND SQUISH IT ALL TOGETHER. MAKE SURE IT'S MIXED WELL.
- 3. TAKE THE DOUGH OUT, AND USING THE BAG AS YOUR CLEAN SURFACE. ROLL THE DOUGH INTO A BALL AND THEN INTO A LONG SAUSAGE SHAPE.
- 5. NOW, YOU NEED TO FIND A CLEAN, FRESH STICK AND WRAP YOUR DOUGH AROUND IT.
- 6. IT'S COOKING TIME PUT YOUR STICK OVER THE FIRE TO COOK, TURNING YOUR STICK SO IT DOESN'T BURN. AFTER A FEW MINUTES YOU'LL HAVE HOT, FRESH, YUMMY BREAD!

S'MORES WHAT YOU'LL NEED

ONE PACKET MARSHMALLOWS A PACK OF DIGESTIVE BISCUITS BIG BAR OF MILK CHOCOLATE



HOW TO COOK IT

- 1. FIND A LONG THIN STICK AND POP YOUR MARSHMALLOW ON IT. TOAST OVER YOUR CAMPFIRE UNTIL BROWN AND GOOEY.
- 2. PLACE A SQUARE OF CHOCOLATE ONTO A BISCUIT AND ADD YOUR TOASTED MARSHMALLOW.
- 3. ADD ANOTHER BISCUIT ON TOP LIKE A SANDWICH, THEN EAT! YOU'LL WANT S'MORES AND S'MORES!

MAKE A WILD FLOWER SEED BOMB

WILD FLOWERS ARE REALLY IMPORTANT FOR BEES AND THE PLANET. HERE'S HOW TO MAKE YOUR OWN WILD FLOWER SEED BOMBS FOR YOUR GARDEN. YOU COULD EVEN MAKE THEM AS GIFTS FOR YOUR FRIENDS!

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

OLD NEWSPAPERS - RIPPED INTO SMALL SQUARES 5 SMALL BOWLS OF WATER, WILD FLOWER SEEDS FOOD PROCESSOR (ASK YOUR PARENTS TO HELP)

LET'S GET MAKING!

PUT A HANDFUL OF NEWSPAPER SQUARES INTO EACH OF THE BOWLS OF WATER AND SOAK FOR 20 MINUTES. SQUEEZE HALF THE WATER OUT OF THE PAPER AND THEN PUT THE PAPER INTO THE FOOD PROCESSOR AND PULSE TO A PULP. PUT THE PAPER PULP BACK INTO THE BOWL AND SPRINKLE SOME WILD FLOWER SEEDS ON TOP. MIX THEM INTO THE PAPER AND SHAPE THE PAPER PULP INTO BALLS. REPEAT FOR THE OTHER BALLS. POP ALL S BALLS ONTO A BAKING SHEET TO DRY OVERNIGHT. PLANT THESE IN YOUR GARDEN IN THE AUTUMN (SEPT-NOV) OR THE SPRING (MAR-APR). WATCH THEM GROW AND ATTRACT HAPPY BEES!

You may be wondering, what are cryptids? Cryptids are legendary creatures whose existence is currently unknown! Glue together some sticks, stones, string and bottle caps to create your own monster footprint maker! Stamp this into the ground and make a trail. A Monster is afoot!



How to make a paper


What you will need:

- Scissors
- Pencil
- Paper plate (or something you can use as a hoop)
- String or wool






Step 1. Cut out the inner circle of your paper plate.




Step 2. Mark in pencil numbers 1-12 (as seen in the diagram) to create the holes and sequence for weaving your dreamcatcher.



Step 3. Use your string or wool to connect the numbers in sequence creating your dreamcatcher.






Step 4. Decorate your hoop however you wish.




Step 5. Use the feather template below to draw around and cut out 3-5 paper feathers for you to decorate and attach using string to the bottom


of your dreamcatcher.




Step 6. Attach a loop of string to the top of your hoop to hang your dreamcatcher










MAKE A TOILET ROLL CROCODILE!

RS THE LEGS. CUT A


