The pages are set to print at A4 size. Make sure to select fit to page. We have created them in black and white for you to colour in and to save your ink.

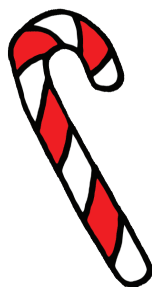
Only print what you need. E.G. print pages 3-4 for just the baubles, 6-7 for the bunting or just page 5 for the gingerbread treat box.

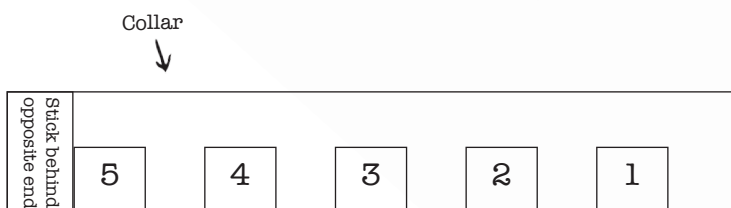
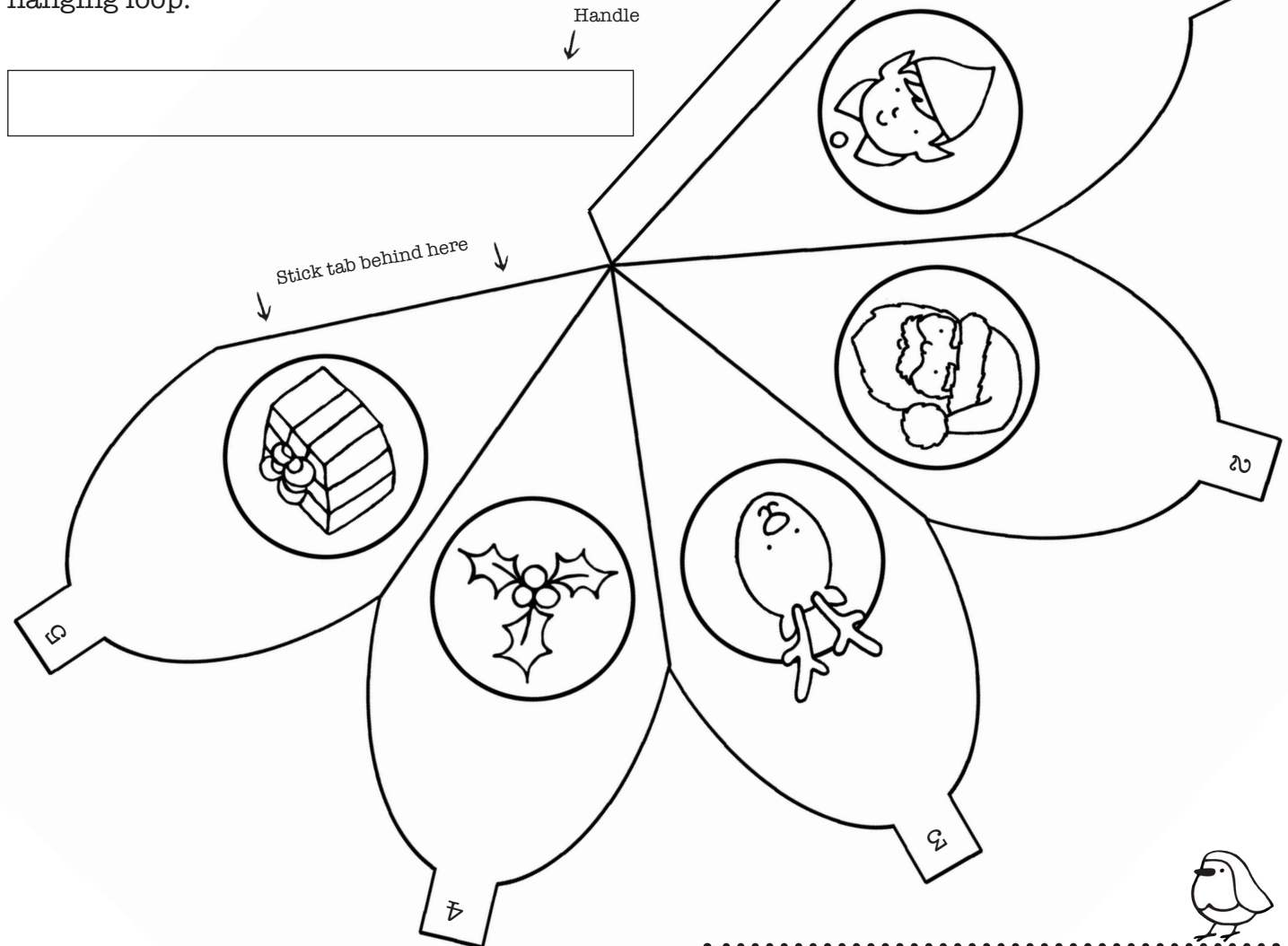
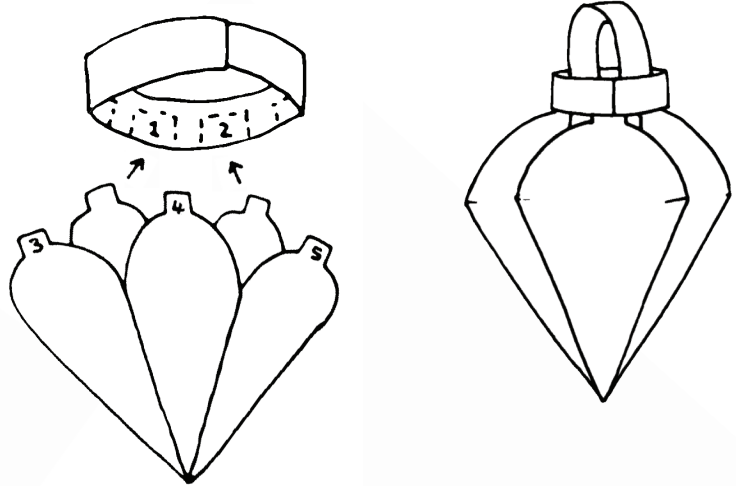

3D Baubles

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut out the template.
2. Fold where shown.
3. Stick the tab where shown to form a cone shape.
4. Cut out the collar and stick where shown to form a ring.
5. Stick the numbered tabs on the bauble to the corresponding numbers on the inside of the collar.
6. Cut out the handle strip and stick to the inside of the collar to make a hanging loop.



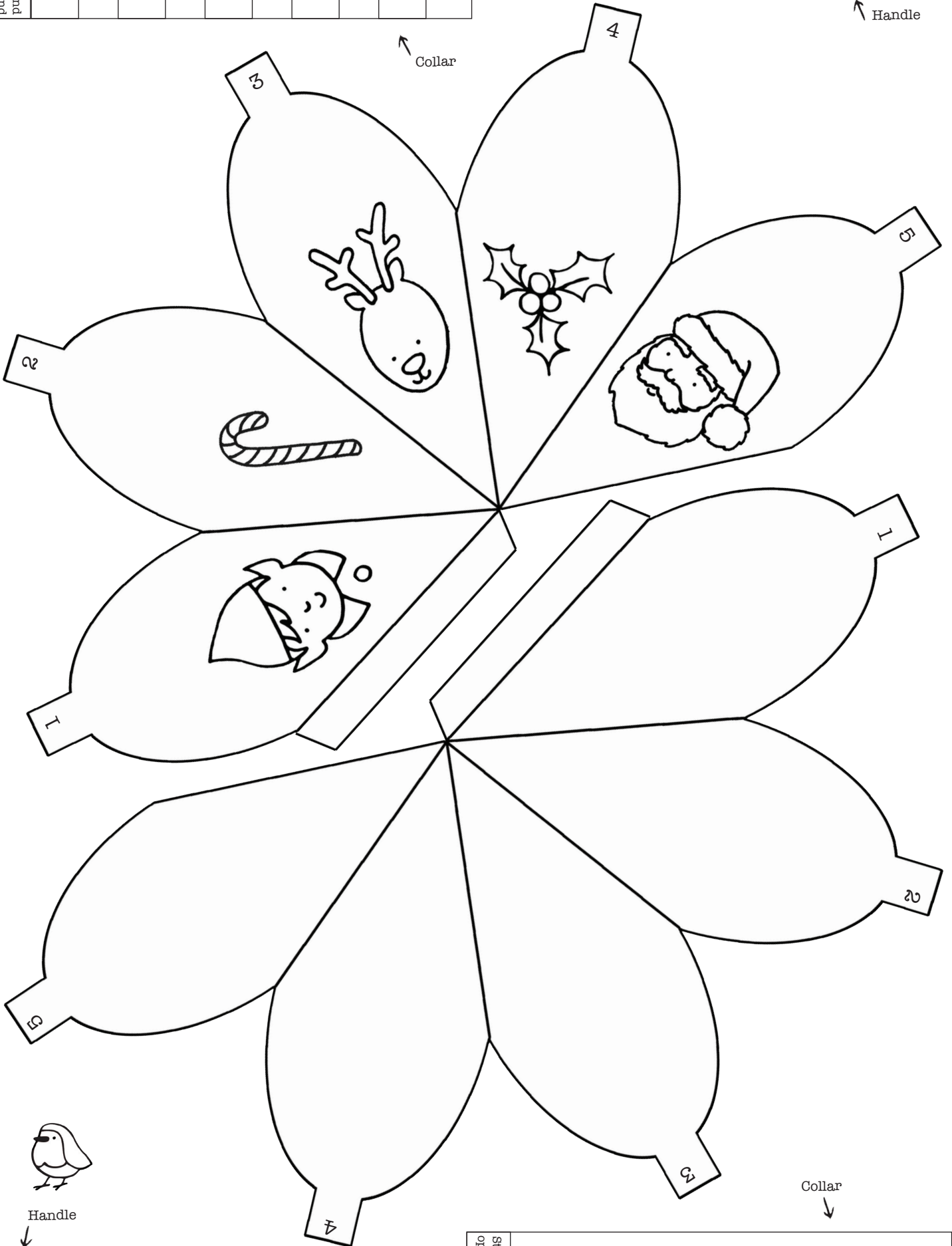
Use the blank template overleaf to make more from any coloured card or paper you have at home. You could make several and string them up to make a garland. Or use them as cute little treat boxes?

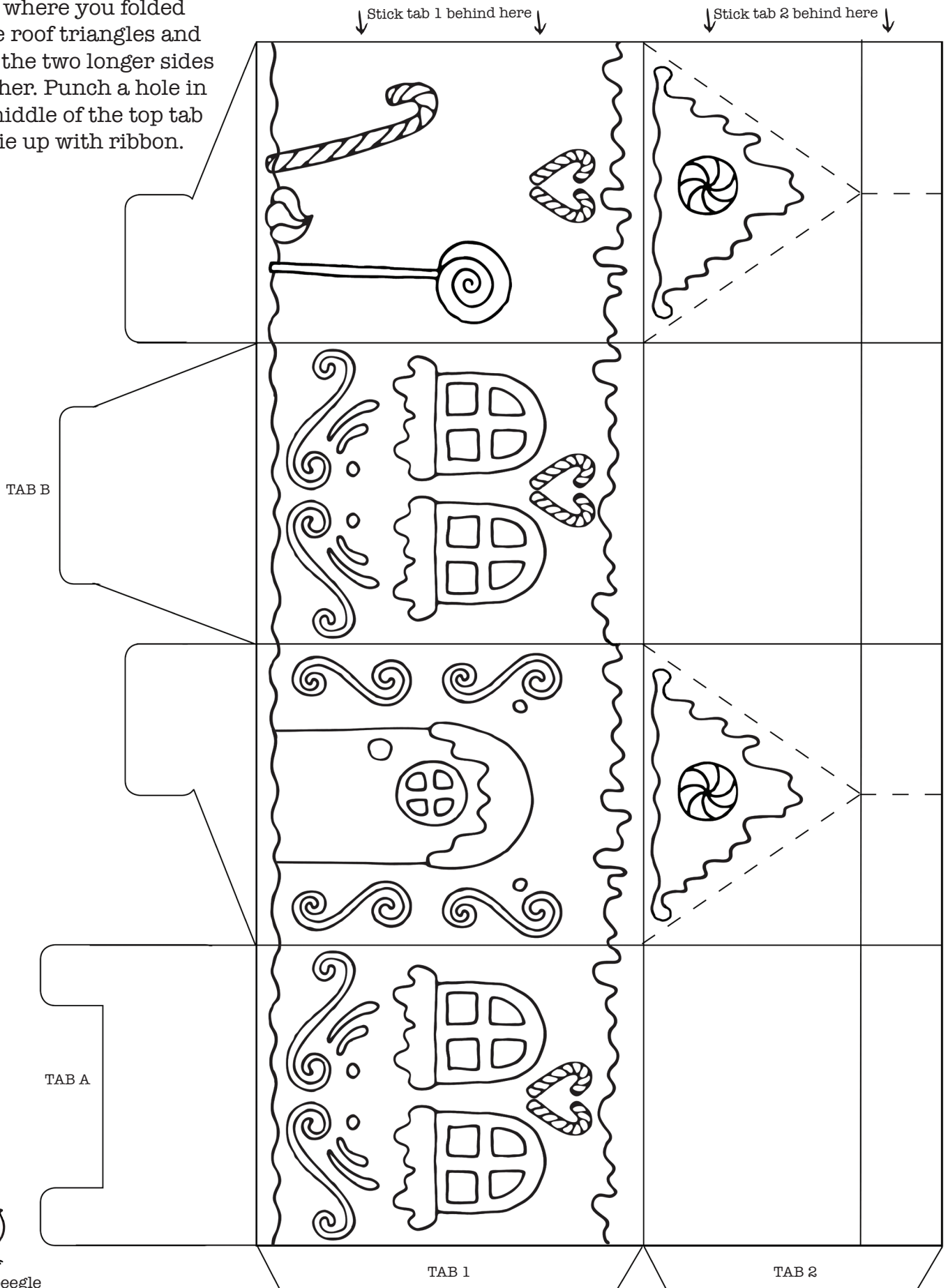

Gingerbread House Treat Box

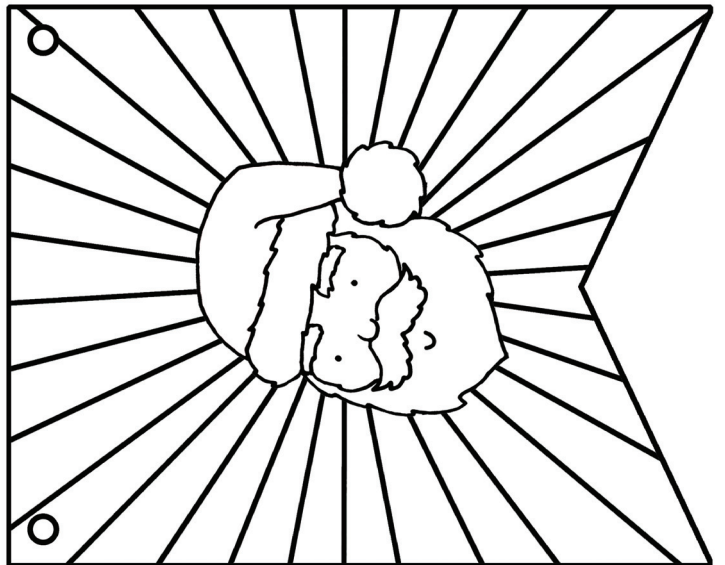
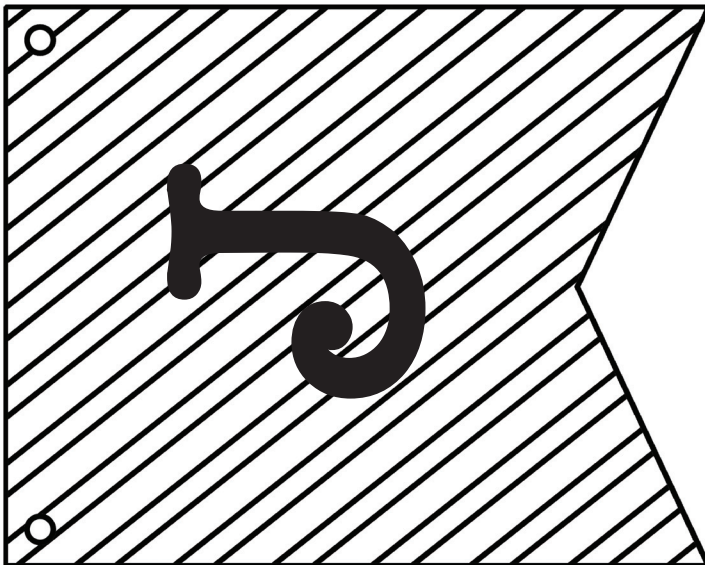
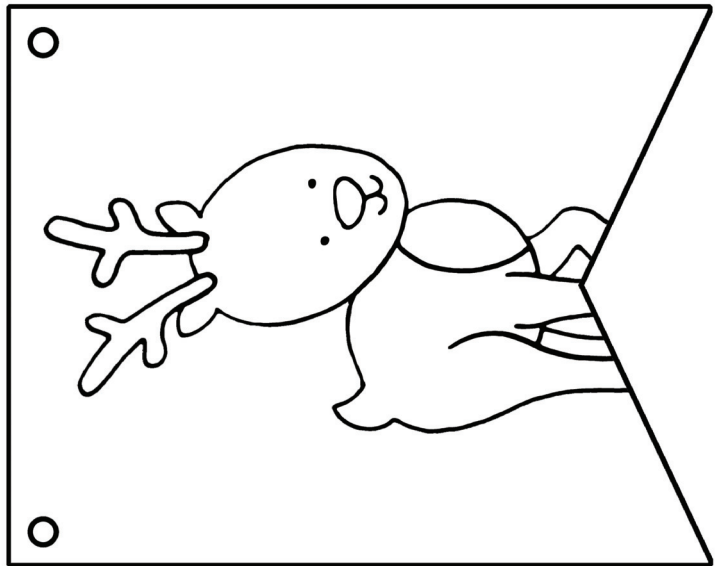
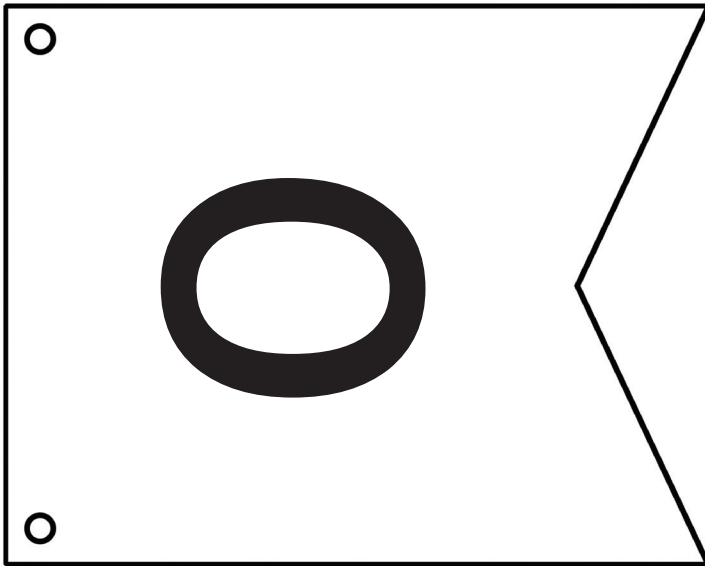
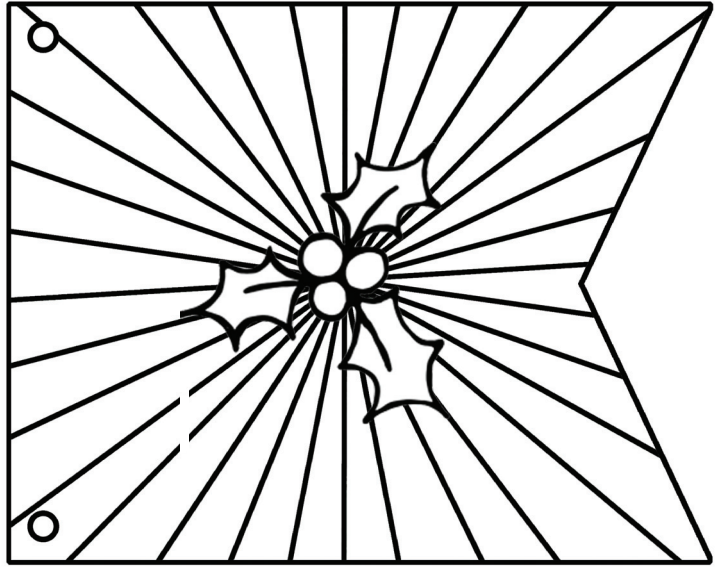
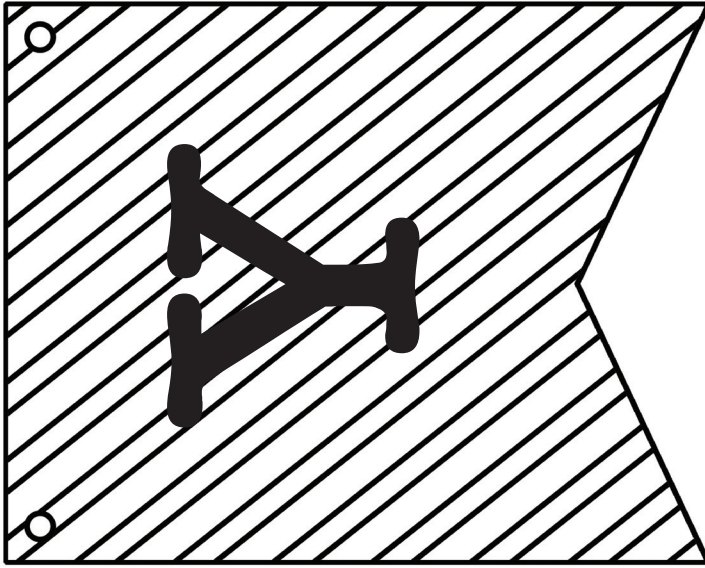
INSTRUCTIONS 1. Cut out the template and colour in. 2. Fold along all of the straight lines. 3. Fold the dashed lines inwards. 4. Stick the tabs where shown. 5. To close the box bottom fold down Tab A first, then the two side tabs then slot in tab B. It should hold well by itself but you can add a small piece of tape to make it extra secure. 6. To close the top push in the sides where you folded in the roof triangles and push the two longer sides together. Punch a hole in the middle of the top tab and tie up with ribbon.

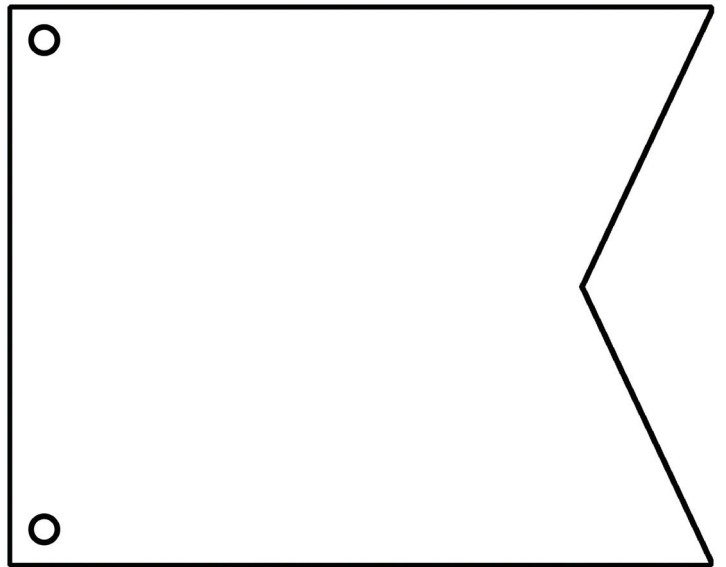
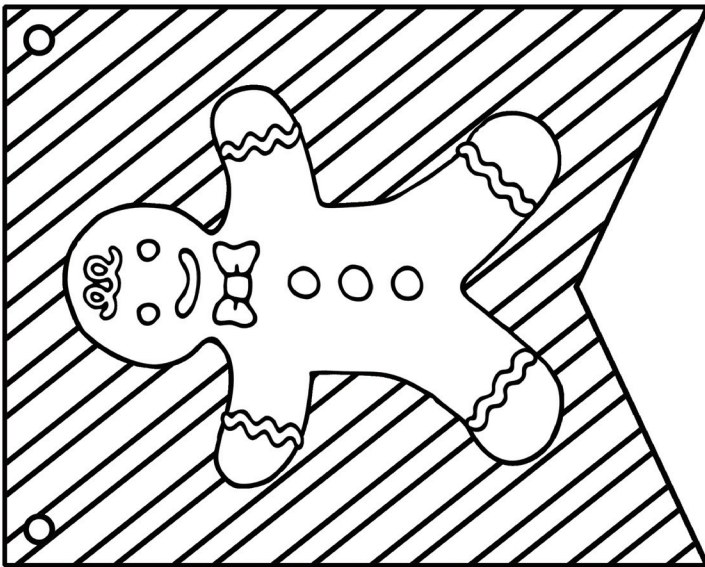
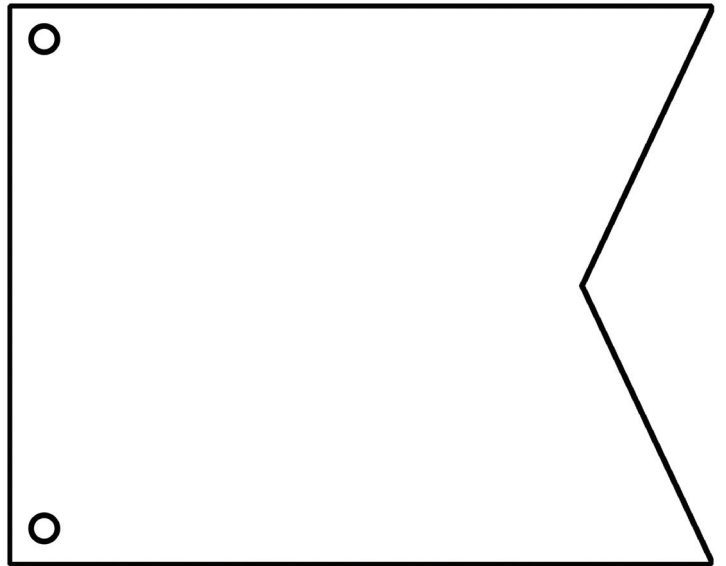
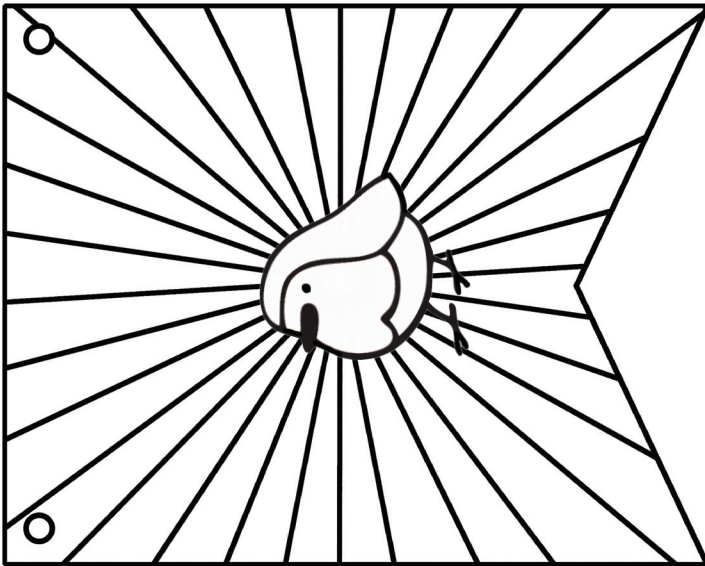
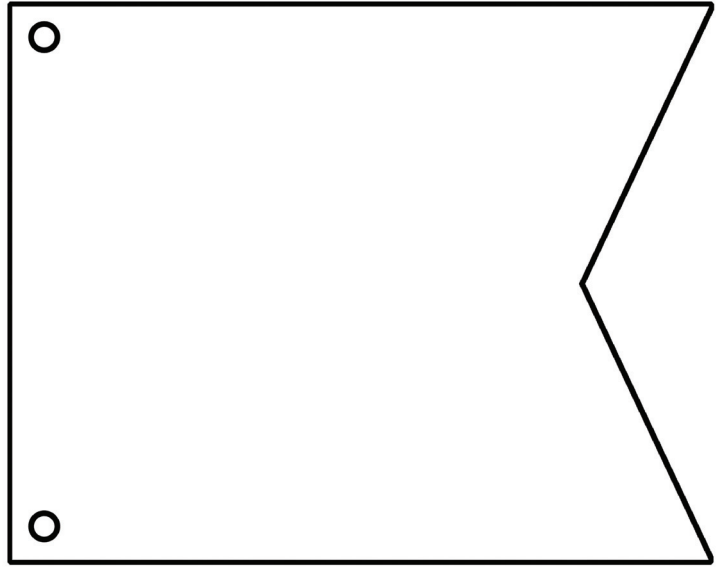
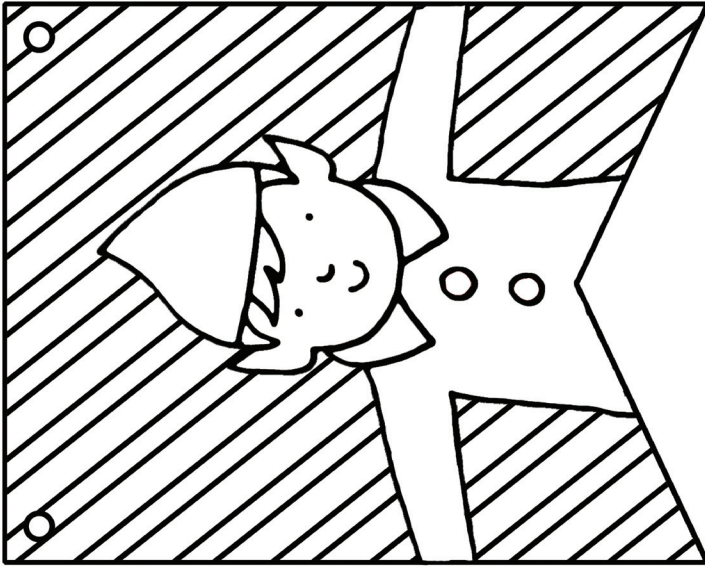


Cut out the flags, colour in, make holes in the top corners where shown and string up!

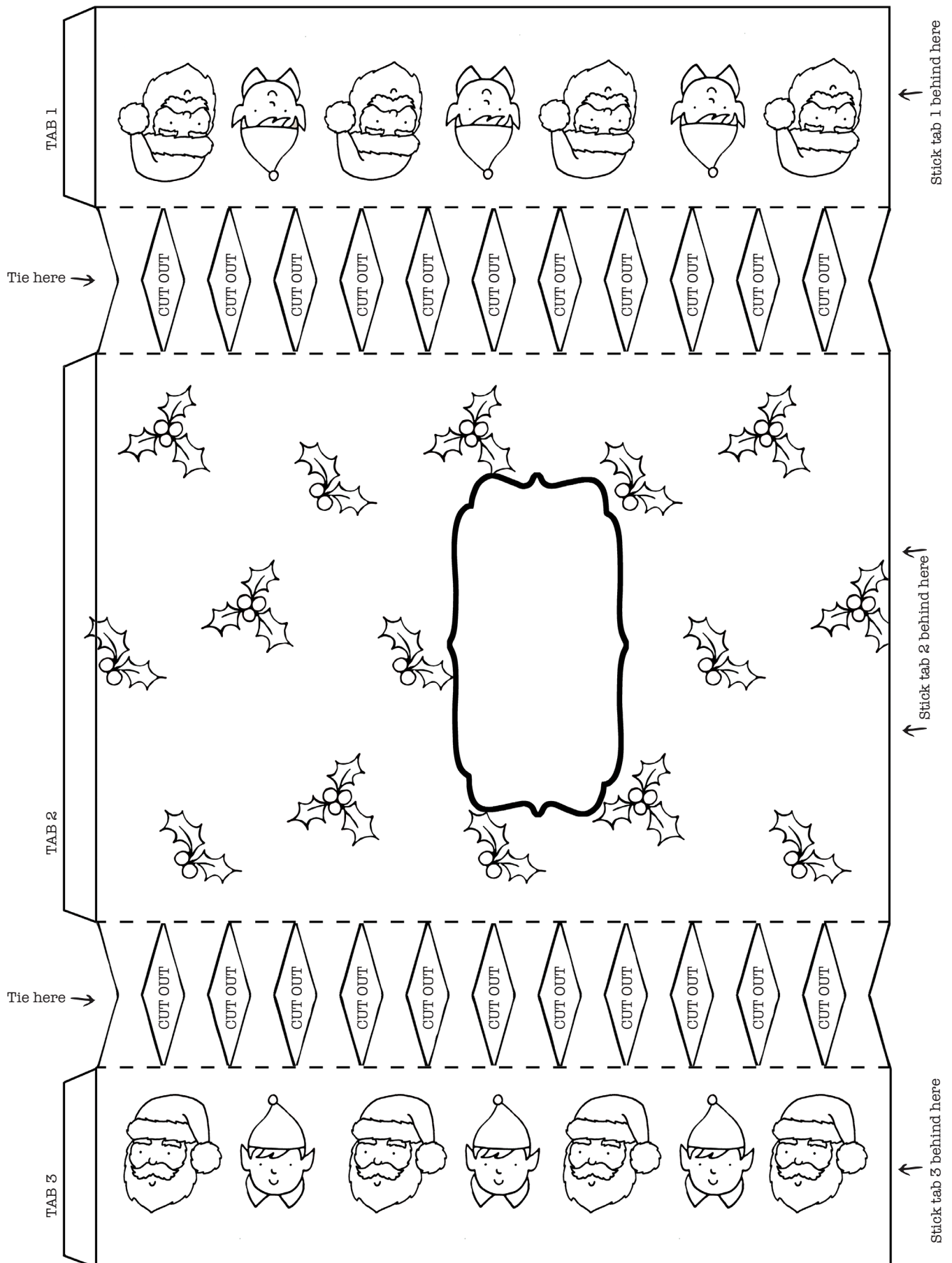


DIY Cracker



INSTRUCTIONS

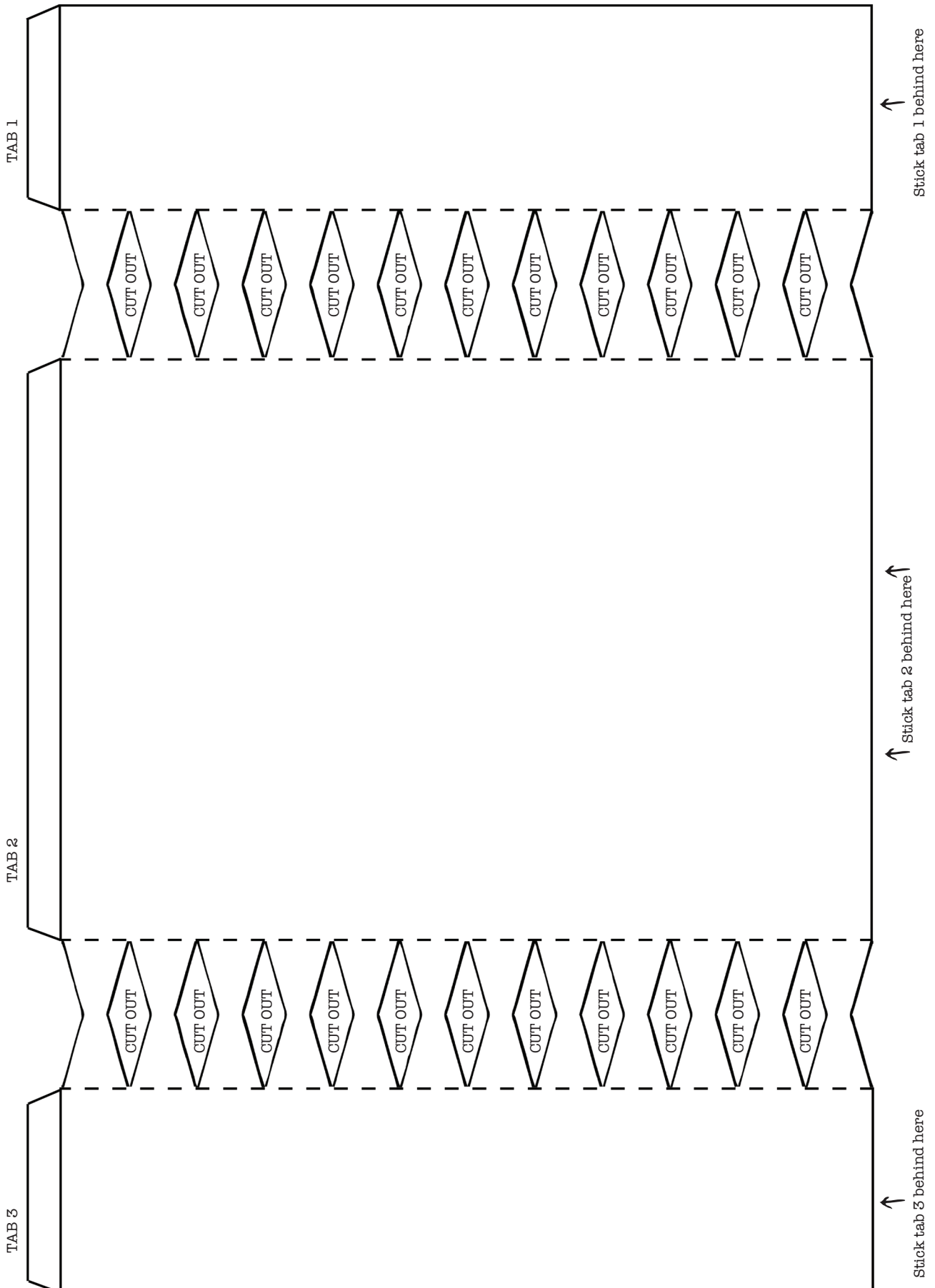
1. Cut out the template and all of the diamond shapes where shown.
2. Score along the dashed lines.
3. Roll into a cylinder and glue tabs where shown.
4. Tie one end with ribbon.
5. Fill your cracker and tie up the other end!

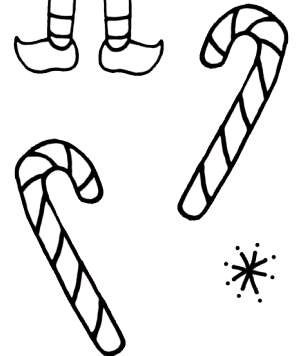
