

3D Baubles


INSTRUCTIONS

- 6. Cut out the handle strip and stick to the inside of the collar to make a





Gingerbread House Treat Box


INSTRUCTIONS 1. Cut out the template and colour in. 2. Fold along all of the straight lines. 3. Fold the dashed lines inwards. 4. Stick the tabs where shown. 5. To close the box bottom fold down Tab A first, then the two side tabs then slot in tab B. It should hold well by itself but you can add a small piece of tape to make it extra secure. 6. To close the top push in the




Cut out the flags, colour in, make holes in the top corners where shown and string up!







DIY Cracker INSTRUCTIONS


1. Cut out the template and all of the diamond shapes

where shown. 2. Score along the dashed lines. 3. Roll into a cylinder and glue tabs where shown. 4. Tie one end with ribbon. 5. Fill your cracker and tie up the other end!
