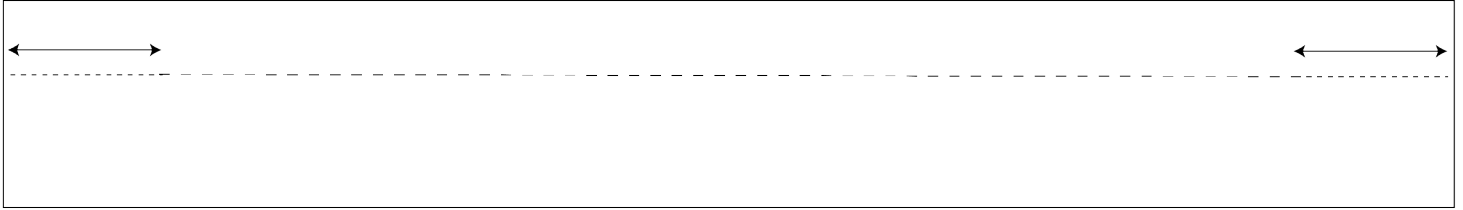
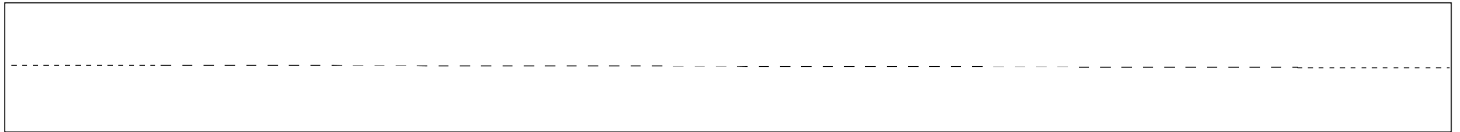


Center Zipper Tutorial

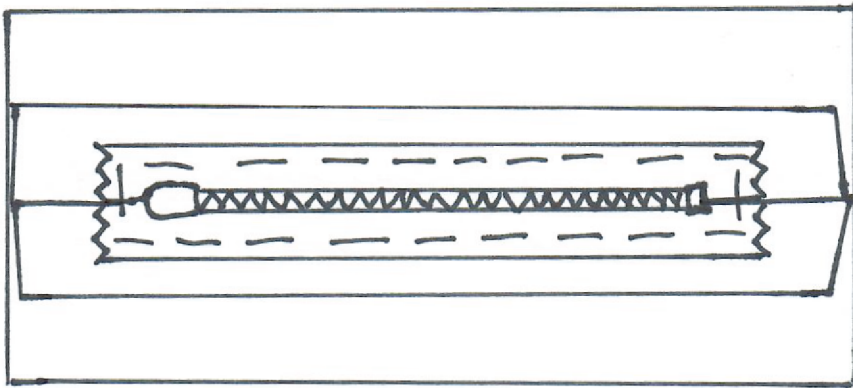
With right sides together, sew a 5/8" seam where your zipper will be placed. The size of your zipper will determine how long you use a large basting stitch. Begin sewing with a backstitch and a regular stitch length then change to your largest basting stitch for the length of your zipper and finish with a regular stitch length and backstitch at the end. The large basting stitch will allow you to easily remove those stitches when your zipper is complete.



Press the seam allowance open.



On the wrong side of the fabric center the zipper on the seam with pull side down. Baste the zipper in place by hand stitching, machine basting, pins, masking tape, or washable glue.



Stitch your zipper down on the top/right side of your fabric. Stitch all around your zipper 3/8" away from the opening using a zipper foot.



Take your basting stitches out with a seam ripper. Press flat.
