

# Fusible Applique

A fast and easy way to applique is with paper backed fusible web.  
Here are the directions for 2 of our favorites.

## Lite Steam-A-Seam 2



Trace your pattern (reversed if not already) onto the paper side (grid side) of the fusible web. Leave about a ½" between pieces so you can roughly cut them out.

Peel the backing paper off the rough cut pattern pieces and stick the texture side down onto the wrong side of your different fabric choices. (If it's not sticking well enough to cut, press lightly with your iron.) Cut out your appliqué pieces on the drawn lines.

Peel away the grid paper and arrange your appliqué pieces on the background fabric the way you want them. Iron/fuse your appliqué pieces onto your background for 30 seconds

To finish the raw edges you can straight stitch, zig zag, or blanket stitch with coordinating, contrasting, or invisible thread.

## Therm-O-Web Heat 'n' Bond Lite



Trace your pattern (reversed if not already) onto the smooth paper side of the heat 'n' Bond Lite. Leave about ½" between appliqué pieces so you can roughly cut them out.

Lay your rough cut pattern pieces onto the wrong side of your different fabric choices. Iron with a pre-heated iron to medium heat, no steam. Place and hold iron on paper for 2 seconds. Cover entire area. Let cool.

Cut out your pieces on the drawn lines.

Peel the paper off and place appliqué pieces adhesive side down. Arrange your appliqué pieces on the background fabric the way you want them.

Place and hold iron on the fabric appliqué pieces for 6 seconds until the entire appliqué is bonded.

To finish the raw edges you can straight stitch, zig zag, or blanket stitch with coordinating, contrasting, or invisible thread.
