



Part 6: Stitches of Harmony

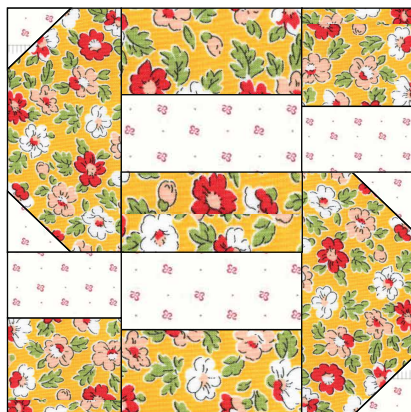
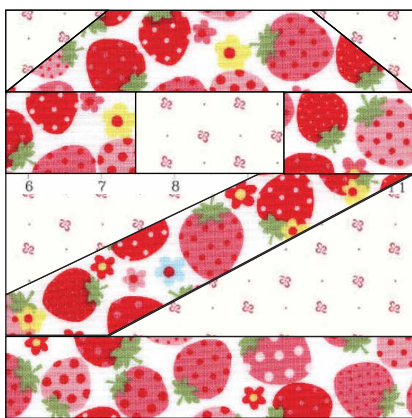
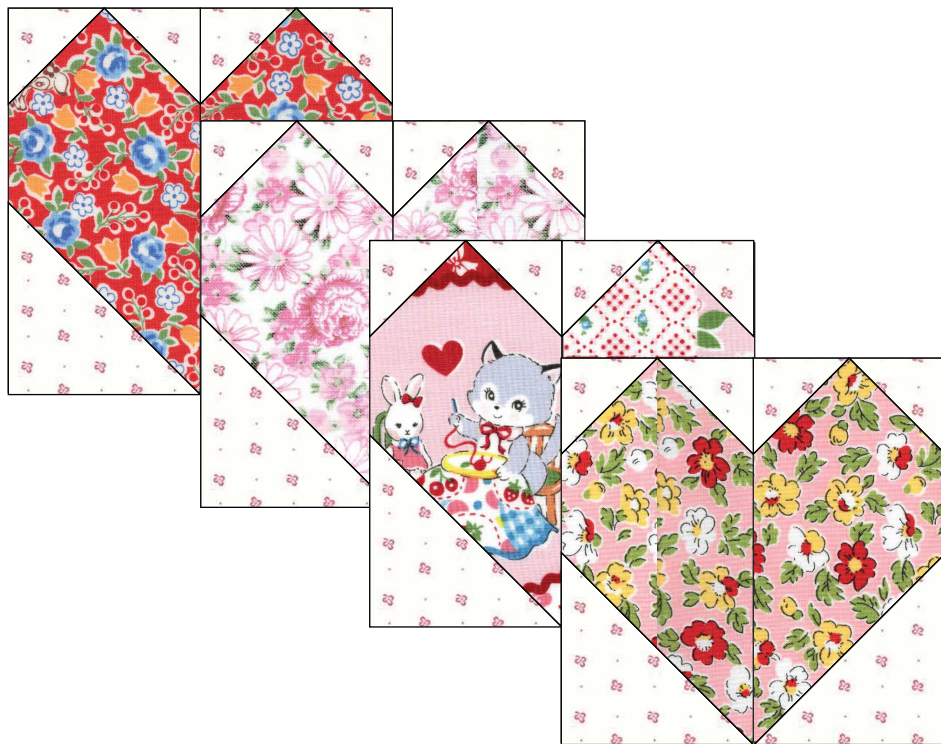

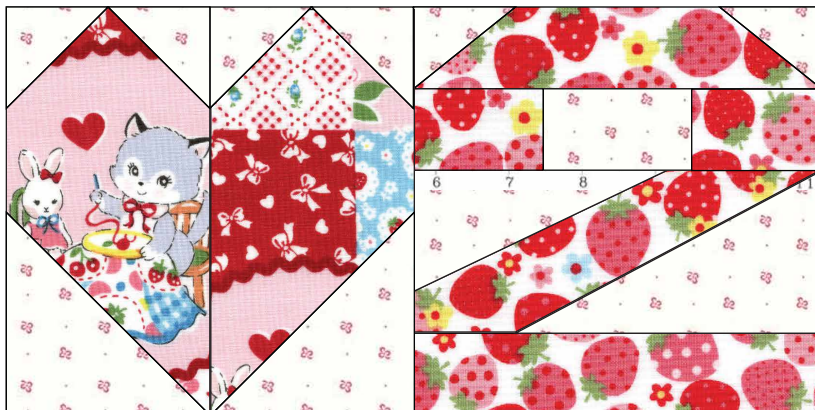
Chapter 6.1: Finishing

1/4" seam allowance throughout

Pull together these Blocks from all of the clues.



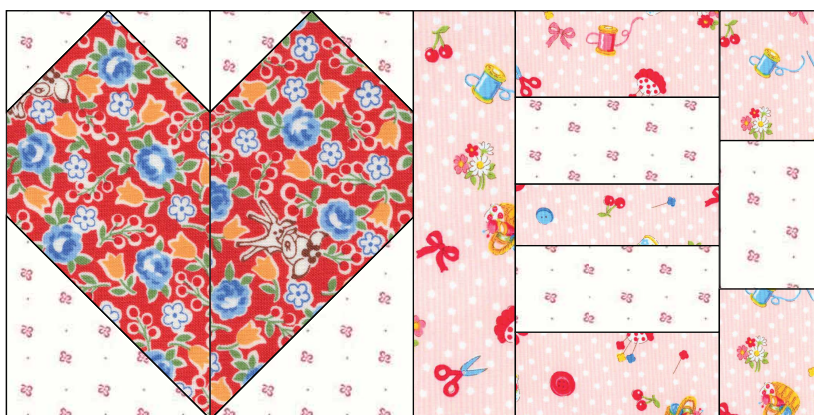
Sew the "2" block to the right side of one of the heart blocks. Press to the right.



Sew the "S" block to the left side of one of the heart blocks. Press to the left.



Sew the "E" block to the right side of one of the heart blocks. Press to the right.



Sew the "W" block to the left side of one of the heart blocks. Press to the left.



Matching center seams,
sew the four sections
together as shown.



Measure the width and height of your quilt.

Sew the three 1 1/2" border strips together along the short sides.

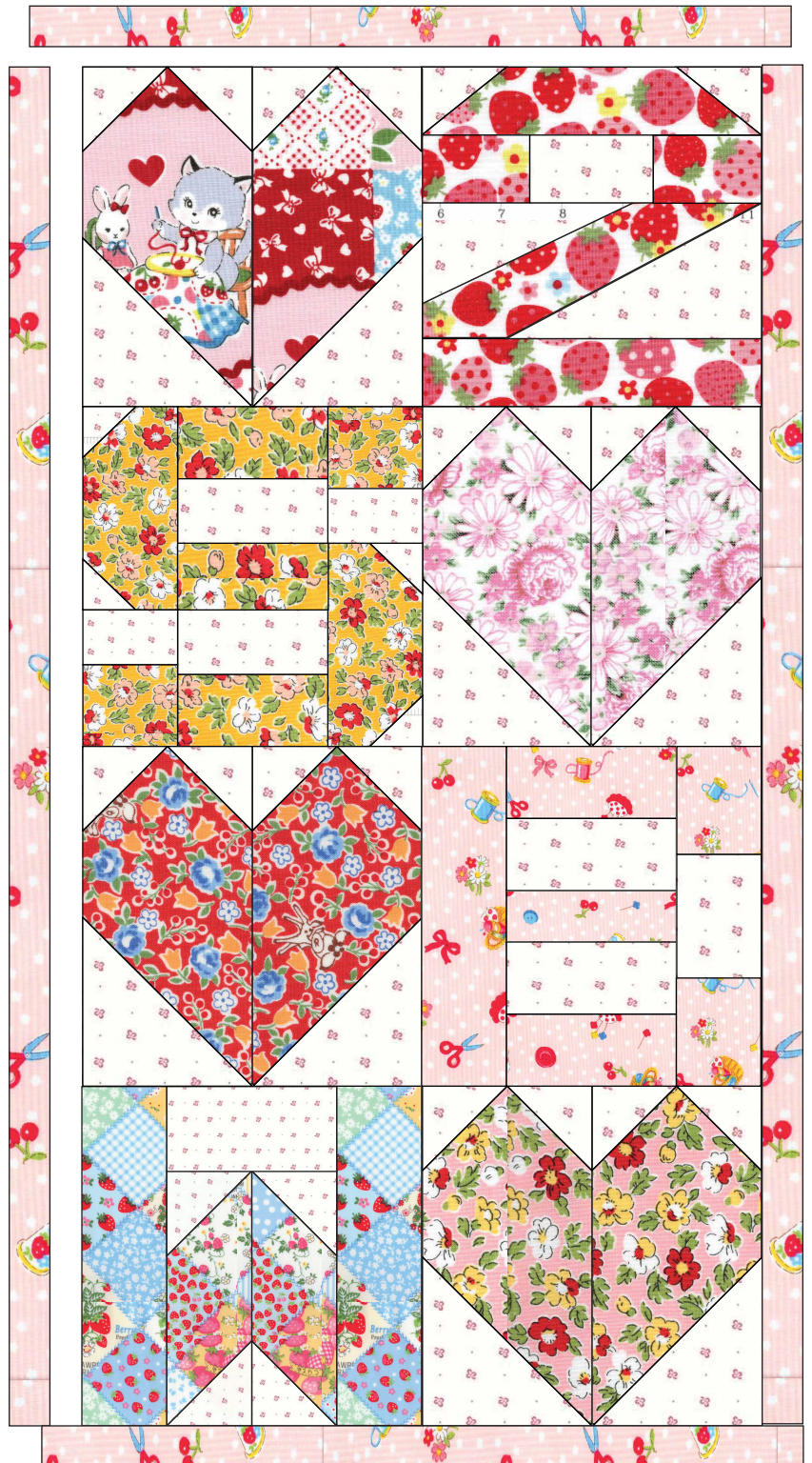
Cut two pieces of the resulting strip the length of the quilt (approximately 32 1/2")

Then cut two pieces the width plus 2" (approximately 18 1/2")

Sew the two long strips to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the border.

Sew the two short strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the border.

Quilt. Bind with the binding strips and enjoy :)
