Mini Pumpkin Centerpiece

Supplies

Pumpkins: You can use any size pumpkin, but for this recipe we are using a small pumpkin like Lil' Pump-Ke-Mon, Iron Man, or even Minis if you plan to do a grouping.

- Gloves
- Green moss
- Spray bottle of water for misting
- An assortment of colorful succulent cuttings
- Spray adhesive
- Glue gun

Directions

1. Prep your work space, and remove the stem from your pumpkin.
2. Spray top of pumpkin with adhesive, and quickly stick a one-inch-thick layer of moss on top.
3. Cut pieces from your succulents in various heights.
4. Using a glue gun, apply glue directly to the base of cutting and tuck them deeply into the moss.
5. Tuck the tallest succulents in the center, and fill in around them with smaller pieces.
6. It's that easy—you've created a fall centerpiece!

Care

Keep out of direct sun and moisture, bright indirect light is best. Mist weekly and the cuttings will begin to root into the moss. This centerpiece is only a temporary home for the succulents, but it should last for a while because you haven't cut into the pumpkin. Once the pumpkin begins to decompose, slice off the top and plant it in a container to create your own succulent dish garden.
