





Supplies

- E.B. Stone™ Organics Cactus & Succulent Mix
- (1) 4" Granite Clay Pot and Saucer
- (1) Sweetheart Hoya and (2) 2" String of Pearls Succulents
- E.B. Stone™ Organics Volcanic Pumice
- E.B. Stone™ Organics Horticultural Sand
- Exotic Pebbles Decorative Stones (Copper, Grey, or Jade colors work well)

Care

Water thoroughly after planting, and then about one time per week after that. depending on the season. Succulents will do best with morning sun and afternoon shade in our climate. Potted indoor succulents need to be near a window that will get indirect sunlight. Fertilize one time per month for best results.

Directions

- 1. Start by selecting your Sweetheart Hoya and String of Pearls succulents.
- 2. Add a small amount of E.B. Stone™ Organics Volcanic Pumice to the bottom of the pot to help with drainage.
- 3. Fill the granite clay pot about halfway with cactus mix, leaving enough room for succulents.
- 4. Add a small amount—about a teaspoon or so—of the horticulture sand to the cactus mix before planting.
- 5. Arrange succulents in the pot, placing String of Pearls near the edge so it can trail over the side.
- 6. Fill in the areas around your succulents with more cactus mix.
- 7. Place a thin layer of decorative pebbles over the top of the soil and around the succulents.
