



# DIY Fairy Garden 2019

## Supplies

- GreenAll® Organic Potting Soil
- E.B. Stone™ Naturals Cactus Mix
- Exotic Pebbles Decorative Stones (mixture of white, brown & black)
- Exotic Fire Glass (Blue)
- Super Moss® Preserved Sheet Moss
- Soil Screen
- 12.5" Chocolate Clay Bowl
- 6" Chocolate Clay Pot and Saucer
- (3-4) 2" Assorted Foliage or Succulents
- Fairy Garden Accessories

## Directions

1. Start by selecting your fairy accessories: a fairy, an arch and a garden sign.
2. Fill clay bowl with soil up to about 1" under rim; placing screen over hole to prevent soil run-off.
3. Create a focal point with the small clay pot: Fill it with soil and place it in the larger bowl to one side.
4. Place the wooden arch into the small pot, add pebbles to create a path underneath it and moss to add color and texture. You can also add a succulent or foliage to the small pot.
5. Position your fairy under the arch, and sprinkle a few of the larger pebbles to provide interest and depth.
6. Use moss to cover some of the bare soil in the large bowl, and create another pebble pathway, leaving room for the clay saucer.
7. Place the saucer and use the blue glass to create your pond.
8. Plant succulents or foliage on either side of the small clay pot, and by the pond, to create your garden.
9. Add your garden sign and a few more moss touches for color.

## Care

Water thoroughly after planting. If you've chosen houseplants, select an indoor spot with indirect bright light. Water when top 1"-2" of soil has dried out, approximately once a week, or more often during very warm periods. Fertilize one time per month for best results. For succulents, select a bright spot inside, or a location outside with morning sun and afternoon shade. Water succulents when soil is completely dry.



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*Tip*

Choose a theme for your fairy garden and then build on the theme over time or change out accessories with the seasons.
