



# DIY SUCCULENT PLANTER

## Supplies

- E.B. Stone™ Cactus Mix
- E.B. Stone™ Sure Start
- One 4" Succulent
- Two 4" Perennials
- 16" Italian Dark Clay Pot

## Directions

1. Pick your plant palette, selecting plants that tolerate similar light and water conditions. For a succulent combo container, chosen plants should require full-to-partial sun and low-to-moderate water.
2. For a visually striking three-dimensional display, try the "Thriller, Filler, Spiller" method:
  - **Thriller:** An upright plant, designed to be the focal point
  - **Filler:** A mounding plant, for nestling into the nooks and crannies
  - **Spiller:** A trailing plant that cascades over the edge of the container, creating depth
3. Fill pot half way with soil, evenly space plants within the container and add starter fertilizer. Back-fill with cactus mix.

## Care

Water thoroughly after planting, and then 2-3 times a week after that, depending on the season. Succulents will do best with morning sun and afternoon shade in our climate. Fertilize every other week for best results.

## Tip

To create a year-round appeal in your container, select plants which have complimentary foliage and flower colors with contrasting textures. This way, even when your container is in-between flowering, it still has visual interest.
