a few relationship issues:

I've neglected it, it's turned its bleached back on me. But I care about our future, so I'm determined to get things back on track with this healthy hair line-up, which focuses on nourishing, repairing and adding an extra few – ahem – inches. But seriously now, this lot are top of their game.

Excess heat and hair are not a match made in heaven. Spritz TRESemmé Protect Heat Defence Styling Spray, £5.49, on to damp hair before blow-drying to protect it to up to 230°C.

Think of Kérastase
Résistance
Extentioniste Serum,
£51.50, as targeted
skincare for your scalp,
kicking it into gear
and encouraging hair
growth. Apply three
pipettes' worth on to
your scalp and
massage in.

Keratin is the protein in hair that gives it structure – so boosting your protein intake can help you on your healthy-hair mission.

WelleCo The Super Elixir Nourishing Chocolate Protein, £28, is vegan, contains nine essential amino acids and tastes delish.

Pop three red capsules in the morning, three white ones at night and let the complex combo of skin, nail and hair boosting ingredients – like omega 3 and vitamin E – do their thing. No wonder Kate Moss is a fan of Lumity, £90 or £76.50 per month.

l've been a big fan of Pureology products for years and have just started with Strength Cure Shampoo, £19.95, and Conditioner, £23.10, which aim to repair colour-damaged, 'micro-scarred' strands with its targeted and sulphate-free formula. I've got high hopes!

If your split ends are spiralling, book in for a trim and follow up with L'Oréal Paris No Haircut Cream, £5.99, which keeps them at arm's length for as long as possible, with castor oil to smooth and keratin to strengthen.
