"Where Two Are Gathered" Variations

The Personified Game

Play normally with one player being the Judge and the other playing one card from their hand. From the remaining cards, add anywhere from 1-4 extra, random cards for the Judge to choose from. The game then acts as additional players. The Judge then picks a card and whom ever played, receives the yellow card. Try to win the game before the game itself does!

Cards Worth Many Sparrows

Each player will need a pen and paper for this variation.

Playing normally with one Judge and one player, the Judge plays a Yellow prompt card. The other player then plays 4 cards from their hand, and on their paper, secretly assigns 1, 2, 4, and 7 points to each card. The Judge picks their card of choice from the four options, and the player who played the cards receives the number of points they gave to that card. Players go back and forth being judge for an agreed upon number of rounds and whom ever has the most points at the end of those rounds wins.
