



‘EASY FOLDED PONCHO’: Ultra Alpaca Version
Instructions for regauging your Churchmouse Classics
‘Easy Folded Poncho’ in Berroco Ultra Alpaca.

Our Easy Folded Poncho is so easy to knit and it transcends the trends. And Ultra Alpaca’s gorgeous blend of silky alpaca and warm, resilient Peruvian Highland wool is perfect for the poncho. Along with a gorgeous drape, the alpaca also drinks up dye for super-saturated colors, including solids and rich, complex heathered shades.

- Yarn:** *Poncho:* 4 skeins Berroco Ultra Alpaca (215 yds/198m each each).
Cowl neck (optional): May require 1 additional skein.
- Needles** US 8 (5mm) 24–32” circular needle, or size to obtain gauge.
& Notions: US 10 (6mm) 24–32” circular needle, or two sizes larger than gauge needle for binding off.
- Gauge:** 18 sts/27 rows = 4”/10cm in stockinette stitch, wet-blocked and steam pressed.

*Please refer to the original pattern for complete instructions.
Only changes are covered in this adaptation. Read original instructions thoroughly.*

- Cast on:** Cast on 100 sts. Work instructions and blocking as per pattern.
- For (optional) cowl neck, you’ll pick up and knit 3 sts for every 4 rows around neck edge (per instructions in *Cowl neck* section), but you will have a different number of stitches compared to original pattern.
