

EASY TRIANGLE SCARF BERROCO SPREE VERSION

Softly-striping and marled Berroco Spree adds endless interest to this simple one-row repeat. The generous size provides many options for styling and the light, cotton/wool fabric will keep your shoulders warm on cool evenings and move gracefully into fall.

Finished Size: Approx. 68"/173cm wingspan x 18"/46cm deep at center, after blocking.

Yarn: 3 skeins Berroco *Spree* (142 yds/130m each).

Or approx. 426 yds/390m of an equivalent DK-weight yarn.

Needles US 8 (5mm) 24–32"/60–80cm circular needle, or size to obtain gauge.

& Notions: US 9 (5.5mm) needle, or one size larger than gauge needle, for binding off.

Blunt darning needle to finish.

Blocking wires and T-pins, or fork blocking pins.

Gauge: Approx. 19 sts/34 rows = 4"/10cm in garter stitch, before blocking.

Approx. 16 sts/24 rows = 4"/10cm in garter stitch, after blocking. Note: Instead of swatching

(yes, we said it), work until you are approx. 5"/13cm deep to check that you like the fabric.

Glossary: Inc('d) = increase(d); **K** = knit; **KFB** = knit into front then back of same st; **St(s)** = stitch(es);

YO = yarn over (bring yarn forward between needles, then back over right needle).

Cast on: With gauge needle, using long-tail cast-on method, cast on 3 sts.

Shaping: Row 1: KFB, YO, knit to end. [2 sts inc'd]

Repeat Row 1 135 more times, making sure to leave at least 14 yds/13m (approx. 5g) for

binding off. [275 sts; 68 eyelets on each short side]

Bind off: Change to <u>larger needle</u> and bind off knitwise, making sure that your bound-off edge

doesn't pull in or flare out.

Finishing: Weave in ends as invisibly as possible along edge of scarf.

Soak for 20 minutes in tepid water with no-rinse wool soap. Gently squeeze out as much water as possible. Roll up in a towel and squeeze again; or place in zippered pillowcase or lingerie bag and run through spin-only cycle in washing machine. Weave blocking wires along bound-off edge, and through eyelets on short sides and pin with a little bit of tension

to desired dimensions. Allow to dry thoroughly.
