

## QUICK MISTAKE RIB COWL

This cowl boasts a lot of complex texture, but with a simple 2 row repeat, it's easy to accomplish. Using a bulky-weight yarn means you can quickly make one up for you and for someone special!

Finished Size: Approx. 24"/60cm around x 10"/25.5cm deep.

Yarn: 2 skeins Rowan Big Wool (87 yds/80m each). Or approx. 135 yds/123m bulky-weight yarn.

Needles US 13 (9.0mm) 24"/60cm circular needle, or size to obtain gauge.

& Notions: 1 stitch marker.

Darning needle to finish.

**Gauge:** Approx.  $10 \text{ sts} = 4^{\text{"}}/10 \text{cm}$  in mistake rib.

Glossary: K = knit; P = purl; St(s) = stitch(es).

Cast on: Using cable cast-on method, cast on 60 sts. Do not join yet.

Set-up row: K1, P2, \*K2, P2\*; repeat between \* \* to last st, K1.

Join in the round, being careful not to twist and place marker to designate beginning of

round. On following rounds, slip marker as you come to it.

Mistake rib: Round 1: \*K2, P2\*; repeat between \* \* to end.

Round 2: K1, P2, \*K2, P2\*; repeat between \* \* to last st, K1.

Repeat Rounds 1 and 2 until piece measures 10"/25.5cm, or to desired depth, making sure

to leave approx. 5 yds/m of yarn for bind-off.

**Bind off:** Bind off firmly in pattern. Cut yarn; fasten off.

Blocking: Use cast-on tail to close gap along cast-on edge. Weave in any remaining ends as invisibly

as possible on WS.

Soak cowl for 20 minutes in tepid water with a little no-rinse wool soap. Gently squeeze out as much water as possible. Roll in towel and gently squeeze out more moisture. Lay flat on blocking board or other moisture-safe surface, gently pulling to finished dimensions.

Allow to dry thoroughly.
