

Ring Size Measurement Guide


Instructions:

Make sure that the page scaling is set to 'None' in your print options. Always print on standard **A4-sized** paper.

The ring sizer's length should be **160mm**.

Using Another Ring as a Measurement of Your Ring Size:

Place your ring over the circles until the inside circumference of the ring matches one of them. If your ring falls in between two sizes, remember that a ring with a wider band may need to be slightly larger to fit properly.



Using The Ring Sizer:

Print and cut out the ring sizer below.

Cut out a slit where indicated by the dashed line, in the widest part of the sizer.

Place the end of the ring sizer through the slit so you are able to wrap it around your finger.

Wrap the loop around the widest part of your finger, with the printed side visible, until it fits snuggly.

The letter indicates your ring size. If inbetween sizes, opt for the next largest size.
