




OPTION 2

Wrap a ribbon snugly around the base of your finger and use a fine point pen to mark the edge of the overlap. Unwrap the ribbon and measure the inches or millimeters up to the marks. Find measurements in the circled above.

OPTION 3

Print this page and cut out the ruler. At the dotted line make a small slit. Wrap the ruler around



^{*}Please note that all of the above options are general guidelines as measuring in this way is less accurate than having your finger measured with a jeweler's ring sizer. Sizing can also vary slightly from day to day, depending for example, on the temperature (fingers shrink in the cold and expand in the heat). Though re-sizing a ring after purchase is possible for most designs, it's important to know there are some limitations.
